invites applications for the post of **Chief Statistician of India**

Position and responsibility: The Chief Statistician of India, (CSI) is a senior level appointment in the rank of Secretary to the Government of India. CSI besides discharging the functions of the Secretary to Government of India in the Department of Statistics will be the head of the National Statistical Organisation and Secretary of the National Statistical Commission.

Qualifications: The applicants shall be Indian Nationals with proven statistical and managerial experience in a large statistical organization. He or she should have attained the age of 52 years and should be below the age of 62 years at the time of appointment.

Conditions of service: CSI will have a tenure of five years or till he/she attains the age of sixty-two years, whichever is earlier and will be eligible for reappointment. CSI will be entitled to the salary and allowances and other facilities like Government accommodation as admissible to a Secretary to the Government of India.

Selection procedure: A Search Committee appointed by the Government of India will recommend a panel of names from among the applicants. Besides the applicants, the Committee may also recommend names of other persons whom it finds suitable in the panel. In the process, the Committee may interview a few applicants. The CSI will be selected from the panel of names recommended by the Search Committee.
