Major initiatives and achievements of the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation during January, 2022

The National Statistical Office (NSO), Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation released Price Movement of Sub-Groups/Groups of Consumer Price Index (CPI) on Base 2012=100 for All India Rural, Urban, Combined for the month of January 2022 (Provisional) and for the month of December 2021 (Final) on 14th February 2022. The General Consumer Price Indices (CPI) for the month of January 2022 (Provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined were 166.4, 165.0 and 165.7, showing an annual inflation rate of 6.12%, 5.91% and 6.01% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for December 2021 were 5.36%, 5.90% and 5.66% respectively.

- 2. All-India Consumer Food Price Index (CFPI) for the month of **January 2022** (Provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined were 162.5, 169.2 and 164.9 respectively. All India year-on-year inflation rates for CFPI for the month of **January 2022** for Rural, Urban and Combined sector were 5.18%, 5.88% and 5.43% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for **December 2021** were 3.39%, 5.08% and 4.05% respectively.
- 3. The All-India Index of Industrial Production (IIP) for the month of **December**, **2021** (Quick Estimates) with base year 2011-12 released on 11th February, 2022 and it stood at 138.0.
- 4. During the month, the Ministry has released Press Notes on First advance Estimates of National Income 2021-22 released on 7th January, 2022; Payroll Reporting in India: An Employment Perspective-November 2021 released on 25th January, 2022; and First Revised Estimates of National Income, Consumption Expenditure, Saving and Capital Formation for 2020-21 on 31st January 2022. The Annual publication of Energy Statistics –India 2022 has also been published and uploaded on the official website of this Ministry.
- 5. The Cabinet has accorded the approval for continuation of Capacity Development (CD) Scheme up to 31/3/2026 with an outlay of Rs 3179 crore. The CD Scheme is an Ongoing Central Sector Scheme of the Ministry with an overall objective to augment infrastructural, technical as well as manpower resources for enabling availability of credible and timely official statistics.

6. The major highlights of Central Sector Projects monitored under Online Computerized Monitoring System (OCMS) by this Ministry for the month of January 2022 are as under:

As per the latest Review Report on the Performance of the Infrastructure Sectors up to the month of December 2021, Power Generation (+8.31%), Import Cargo handled at Airports (+20.92%), Passenger traffic handled at International terminal of the Airports (+59.33%) and Passenger traffic handled at Domestic terminal of the Airports (+11.47%) exceeded its targets.
- 8. The Sectors that fell short of their targets are Coal (-11.20%), Fertilizers Production Production (-16.28%), Crude (-4.47%), Refinery Oil Production Production (-0.97%), Natural Upgradation of Highways by NHAI (-20.46%), Upgradation of Highways by State Production (-8.75%), Gas PWD & Border Road Organization (BRO) (-17.77%), Railways (-1.30%), and Export Cargo handled at Airports (-1.79%).
