Major initiatives and achievements of the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation during May 2019

On the Statistics side, the Ministry has released monthly Index of Industrial Production (IIP) and the Consumer Price Index (CPI). The salient features of these are:

As per the Quick Estimates (QE) of Index of Industrial Production (IIP) with base year 2011-12 released on 12th May 2019, the general index for the month of March, 2019 stood at 140.2, which is 0.1% Lower as compared to the level in the corresponding month

of previous year.

The General Consumer Price Indices (CPI) with base year 2012 for the month of April 2019 (provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined showed an annual inflation rate of 1.87%, 4.23% and 2.92% respectively. The Consumer Food Price Indices (CFPI) for April 2019 (provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined showed an annual inflation rate of -0.80%, 4.64% and 1.10% respectively.

2. Our monitoring of the infrastructure sector highlighted the following:

As per the latest Flash Report for the ongoing Central Sector Projects costing ₹ 150 crore and above of March 2019:

As per the latest Review Report on the Performance of the Infrastructure Sectors for the month of March 2019, Power Generation (+8.78%), Coal Production (+0.05%), Refinery Production (+1.30%) and Goods traffic carried by Railways (+0.41%) exceeded their

targets.

The Sectors that fell short of their targets are Fertilizers Production (-14.71%), Crude Oil Production (-7.59%), Natural Gas Production (-7.66%), Upgradation of Highways by NHAI (-43.66%), Upgradation of Highways by State PWD & Border Road Organization (BRO) (-27.72%), Export Cargo handled at Airports (-10.44%), Import Cargo handled at Airports (-11.76%), Passenger traffic handled at International terminal of the Airports (-3.53%) and Passenger traffic handled at Domestic terminal of the Airports (-2.47%).

4. Under MPLADS, an amount of ₹ 57.50 crore have been released during the Month of May 2019 and the total fund released during the financial year 2019-20 up to 31st May 2019 is ₹ 57.50 crore.

5. Status report on Minimum Government, Maximum Governance:

A new integrated MPLADS portal, developed on state-of-the-art technology platform with built-in security features is in operation. This new portal provides single point of reference for all stakeholders including Members of Parliament and District Authorities. All MPLADS funds releases are being made only through PFMS & information about release of funds is uploaded on the website. The Ministry is regularly organizing training programmes for the district officials on the new website.
