Call for Nominations- 'Prof. P. C. Mohalanobis National Award in Official Statistics for the year 2020

In order to promote excellence and recognizing outstanding contributions made by the Official Statisticians in the area of Official/Administrative Statistics in India, the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation has instituted 'Prof. P. C. Mohalanobis National Award in Official Statistics'. Maximum of 3(three)Awards will be given annually for outstanding and meritorious contribution of an individual for development and promotion of official statistics that has immensely benefitted the Indian Official Statistical System or the benefits that may accrue in the near future, particularly, but not limited to, in the fields of (i) Sample Surveys (ii) National Accounts (iii) Index Numbers (iv) Social Statistics (iv) Automation in collection, compilation and dissemination of data and (v) Data Storage and Dissemination (vi) Statistical Systems (vii) Big Data (viii) Data Warehouse and (xi) Management Information System (MIS).

- 2. There will be 3(three) categories of award. One award (Category A) will be for inservice Official Statistician with less than 45 years of age; (Category B) will be for inservice Official Statistician above 45 years of age; and (Category C) will be for non-serving/retired Official Statisticians for their lifetime achievements, who served in the Government/Autonomous Bodies throughout his/her career.
- 3. The awards will consist of a Citation (signed by the Chief Statistician of India –cum-Secretary, Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, Government of India), a cash prize of ₹2,00,000/- (Rupees two lakh only) and a Memento. The awardees will be entitled for payment of TA/DA as per rules and entitlement applicable to them.
- 4. **Eligibility:** Any in-service Official Statistician in Central Government, State Governments and Autonomous Bodies, who is less than 45 years of age for Category A and more than 45 years of age for Category B and non-serving/retired Official Statisticians, who served in the Government/Autonomous Bodies throughout his/her career with more than 55

years of age for Category C, as on 31st December of the financial year in which advertisement of the award is published is eligible for the Award.

5. Nominations are invited for 'Prof. P. C. Mohalanobis National Award in Official Statistics' for the year the 2020. Nominations for the Award should be proposed by Heads of Central Ministries / Departments and State Departments and Autonomous Bodies. Each of them can send normally a maximum of two nominations in each category. The nominations should be sent in the prescribed proforma along with the resume/synopsis, highlighting the salient features of the work done by the candidate with supporting documents, to "Joint Director, Training Unit, National Statistical Office, Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, 3rd Floor, Wing - C, Pushpa Bhawan, Madangir Road, New Delhi–110062 and also at Email: training-mospi@gov.in" before 17th February 2020.
