Subject: Constitution of a High Level Steering Committee for review of National Indicator Framework for monitoring of SDGs –reg.

It has been decided with the approval of the Cabinet to constitute a High Level Steering Committee (HLSC) under the chairmanship of Chief Statistician of India and Secretary, Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) to periodically review and refine the National Indicator Framework (NIF) for monitoring Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) with associated targets.

3. The Terms of Reference (TOR) of HLSC are

- (a) To review and refine the National Indicator Framework with a view to add additional indicators, modify or delete the existing indicators.
- (b) To consider and approve the methodology for computation of new additional and modified national indicators.

- (c) To constitute sector specific sub-committee viz., Technical Advisory Committee under the chairmanship of Director General, MoSPI, to examine and suggest addition/ deletion/ modification of indicators and their methodology for National Indicator Framework. The recommendation of the Technical Advisory Committee will be submitted to the Committee for its consideration and approval.
- (d) To suggest and recommend new surveys to collect data for the indicators where data is not available on the recommendation of Technical Advisory Committee.
4. The Committee may co-opt any other Secretary or their representative as a member, as necessary, for deliberating on the NIF.
5. This issues with the approval of Hon`ble Minister of Statistics and Programme Implementation.
