Call for Nominations- Prof. P.V. Sukhatme National Award 2020 for Lifetime Contributions and Achievements in the field of Statistics

The Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation has instituted a National Award in the memory of Prof. P.V. Sukhatme, a renowned statistician for his outstanding contribution and the distinguished service to the cause of Statistics and its application to agriculture and allied fields. This award is given in alternate years to the senior Indian Statisticians for their Lifetime Contributions and Achievements in the field of Statistics. The first Award was given in the year 2000. The award carries a cash prize of Rs. 5,00,000/-. Expenditure on travel (by Air India-economy class) to the venue of the Award presentation ceremony, boarding and lodging would be provided to the awardee for participating in the award presentation ceremony.

Nominations are now open for the 2020 Award. Candidates can nominate themselves or the names can also be proposed by their institution accompanied by a support of three referees. The Award Committee of the Ministry can also identify and nominate candidates. The candidate should:

- (i)Be an Indian National with no age bar.
- (ii) Have made significant/ lifetime contributions in applied/ theoretical Statistics benefitting the Indian Official Statistical System.
- (iii) Have acquired the degree of Ph.D. / D.Sc.
