Call for applications/Nominations for Prof. C.R. Rao National Award in Statistics-2017

Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation has instituted two National Awards in Statistics in the names of two renowned Statisticians- one in the memory of Prof. P. V. Sukhatme and the other in the honour of Prof. C. R. Rao. These awards are given in the alternate years. For the year 2016-17 the National Award in honor of Prof. C.R. Rao to a young statistician will be conferred on the selected statistician during statistics day celebration on 29th June 2017.

2. Nominations/applications in prescribed format are invited for “Prof. C.R. Rao National Award in Statistics for Young Statisticians for 2017”. Details about the Award and Eligibility criterion is as under :-

3. The Award :-

- i) Prof. C.R. Rao National Award in Statistics carries a cash prize of Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs) Only along with a citation and Memento.
- ii) The Awardee is entitled to travel expenses (for travel by air- Air India by economy class) and free boarding and lodging for the travel/tour undertaken to receive the award. Boarding and lodging facilities for the awardee(s) may be arranged by Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation (MOS&PI). However, in case boarding & lodging facilities are not arranged by MOS&PI, the awardee(s) will be entitled for reimbursement of expenditure on boarding and lodging in accordance with rates/norms applicable to the officers of Joint Secretary level in Govt. of India.

4. Eligibility Criterion for Prof. C.R. Rao National Award in Statistics

The nominee/applicant should:-

- i) Be Indian National of less than 45 years of age as on 31st December 2016.
- ii) Has made significant and outstanding contributions in Applied/Official Statistics, significantly benefiting the Indian official statistical system in the past and/or benefits that may accrue in near future.
- iii) Has acquired a degree of Ph.D/D.Sc.

5. Procedure for selection of awardee

- i) The selection of awardee for Prof. C.R. Rao National Award in Statistics 2017 will be done in two stages. Based on nominations received, a Screening Committee chaired by Director General, CSO, Central Statistics Office would recommend names to the Award committee chaired by CSI & Secretary (S&PI) for final selection.
- ii) While deciding the suitable candidate for the award, the Screening Committee and the Award Committee would give due preference to the contributions made in the field of Applied Statistics benefiting the Indian official statistical system in the past and or benefits that may accrue in near future. The decision of the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, Government of India will be final, in this regard.
- iii) The award can also be conferred posthumously.

6. Submission of applications/nominations:-

- i) Applications/nominations of the eligible candidates, in the prescribed format (attached hereunder), along with applicant/nominee's resume/synopsis highlighting the statistical work done may be sent, **in Ten Copies**, to the Director, Training Unit, Central Statistical Office, 9th Floor, Jeevan Prakash Building, 25, Kasturba Gandhi Marg, New Delhi- 110001 so as to reach the same **latest by Monday the 16th January 2017**.
- ii) Hard copy/Print out of five most significant publications/research papers may also be forwarded along with the application.
