Minutes of meeting of Screening Committee held on 18.07.2024 at 11.00 AM for considering the cases for appointment on compassionate ground in NSSO (FOD) for the period April, 2020 to December, 2023.

The Meeting of Screening Committee for appointment on compassionate ground in NSSO (FOD) was held on 18.07.2024 at 11.00 AM under the Chairmanship of Shri Arun Kumar Yadav, Deputy Director General (Admn.) for considering the cases against the vacancy years April, 2020 to December, 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023. For considering the cases for appointment on compassionate ground, a uniform policy in NSS for processing cases for appointment on compassionate grounds. Accordingly, uniform guidelines have been developed in NSS by MoS&PI vide O.M.No.A-12012/3/2019-CSW-MOS&PI/SCD(E-28167), dated 26.06.2020 and the applications were invited from the dependants family members of the deceased Govt. Servant afresh. As on 01.04.2024, 24 applications complete in all aspect were received.


2. The work relating to Compassionate appointment stands decentralised w.e.f. 2009-10 vide MoS&PI letter No. A-12030/2/2000-Ad.II(Part), dated 16.09.2009 and the optimization policy has been reviewed in consultation with the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance and it has been decided Not to Extend the validity of the Optimization Scheme beyond 31.03.2009 vide DoP&T O.M. F.No.2/8/2001-PIC, dated 09.04.2009.

3. As per the guidelines, the monetary parameters i.e. family pension and terminal pensionary benefits will be evaluated as per 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> CPC applicable at the time of death of the deceased Govt. servant alongwith other non-monetary parameters/attributes viz. No. of Dependant(s), No. of Unmarried Daughter(s). No. of Minor Children and left over service will be decided as per the guidelines issued by MoS&PI vide O.M. dated 26.06.2020.


4. The committee examined all the cases based on the 100 point standard evaluation criteria having 20 marks for Family pension, 10 marks for terminal benefits, 5 marks for monthly income of earning member(s) and annual income from movable/immovable property, 10 marks for latest market value of movable/immovable property, 15 marks for number of dependents, 15 marks for number of unmarried daughters), 15 marks for number of minor children and 10 marks for left over service.

5. The committee was informed that the vacancies in the categories of Group 'C' for the period from 2016-17, 2017-2018, 2018-2019 and 2019-2020 were taken into account in the meeting held on 23.02.2021. There were 92 vacancies in Group 'C' cadres (38 in MTS, 40 in LDC and 7 in Stenographer Gr.II including 7 previous carried forward vacancies) and 5% of 92 vacancies were 4.6, rounded off to 4 vacancies. Accordingly, the Screening Committee considered applications of 44 candidates for these 4 vacancies in the meeting and Four persons who got highest points in "100 points system" were appointed. remaining 12 vacancies were carried forward for inclusion in the next meeting. Hence, these 12 vacancies have been presently taken into account in this meeting alongwith vacancies for April,2020 – December 2020 , 2021, 2022 and 2023 for calculation of 5% quota for appointment on compassionate ground.

6. There were 14 vacancies in the year April 2020- Dec.2020, 23 vacancies in the year 2021, 19 vacancies in the year 2022 and 39 vacancies in the year 2023. Hence, the total cumulative vacancies comes to **107** in Group 'C' (i.e 38 in MTS, 41 in LDC and 16 in Stenographer Gr.II, which includes 12 carried forward vacancies of earlier meeting). All the above **107** vacancies have arisen due to retirement, resignation, promotion, death, absorption and transfer in Group 'C' in PB-1 with Grade Pay of Rs.1800, Rs.1900 and Rs.2400 in the direct entry grade.

7. Thus, 5% of **107** vacancies works out to 5.35 and hence, the Committee decided to exclude **7** vacancies (in Group 'C') from the existing 107, so as to calculate 5% of **100** vacancies which comes to **5**. The remaining **7** excluded vacancies will be taken up in the next meeting for the purpose of calculation of 5% quota under compassionate appointment.

8. The Committee observed that 24 completed applications were received as on 01.04.2024 for the compassionate appointment.

9. The Screening Committee considered all the 24 cases based on 100 point parameters, namely Family Pension and other parameters such as Terminal benefits, as per 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> CPC as the case may be, at the time of death, financial conditions, Service remaining at the time of death, etc. The points scored by each of the applicants is given below :-

Based on the 100 point system subject to veracity of claims by applicants and after verification of documents, the Committee unanimously agreed and decided to recommend on merit (Sl.No.1, 2, 3, 4 & 5 of table under Para-9 above) as per prescribed parameters, for appointment on compassionate ground, against the available four vacancies in Group 'C' under 5% for compassionate appointment. Candidates at Sl.No. 1 to 4 selected who scored highest marks in the merit list. 44 marks was scored by applicants at Sl.No. 5 and 6 ( Considering criteria based on resolution of tie cases adopted by SSC and Left over service of the deceased Govt. Servant, Name of Fifth candidates selected). Accordingly, the Committee recommends for compassionate appointment with details below :-
