ORDER

Subject:- Subject:- Identification of the new areas / posts as sensitive, for implementation of rotational transfer policy the new areas / posts as sensitive - reg.

The Central Vigilance Commission vide Circular No. 22/10/22 dated 25.10.2022(copy enclosed) desired that the CVO's, in consultation with the Chief Executive / Management of the respective organizations, should immediately undertake exercise to identify sensitive posts in their organizations and in future, an exercise to review and identify sensitive posts may be conducted after interval of every three years. Further, Central Vigilance Commission vide Circular No. 03/09/13 dated 11.09.2013 (copy enclosed) stated to ensure that the officials holding sensitive posts are **strictly rotated after every two/three years to avoid developing vested interests.**

02. Consequently, in compliance with the above instructions issued by Central Vigilance Commission, a Committee was constituted to identify the sensitive posts. Based on the recommendations of the Committee during its meeting held on 12th October, 2023, sensitive posts were declared vide order dated 4th December, 2023.

03. However, a need was felt to re-review the sensitive posts notified vide order dated 4th December, 2023. Accordingly, the sensitive posts notified vide order dated 4th December, 2023 were re-reviewed by the said Committee in its meeting held on 23.02.2024. Based on the recommendations of the Committee and with the approval of the Competent Authority, the following posts are declared as sensitive for implementation of rotational transfer as per CVC's guidelines :-

- a. The posts up to Director/Deputy Secretary and below, within the main Ministry as well as its all constituents viz, NSSO(FOD), DPD(DQAD), SDRD, NSSTA, Computer Centre - dealing with Cadre

management/procurement/vigilance/Cash/financial matters are declared as sensitive posts.

- b. The Head of Departments/Head of Office(s)/DDOs exercising the administrative and financial powers in the main Ministry as well as its all constituents viz, NSSO(FOD); DPD(DQAD); SDRD; NSSTA; Computer Centre; - are declared as sensitive posts.
- c. The DDG /Head of Departments/ Head of Office(s)/ DDOs exercising the administrative and financial powers in Zonal, Regional and Sub-regional Offices are declared as sensitive posts.

04. The maximum tenure to hold the sensitive posts will be governed by the CVC's Circular No. 22/10/22 dated 25.10.2022; Circular No. 03/09/13 dated 11.09.2013; Circular No. 07/02/22 dated 03.02.2022(copies enclosed) and circulars issued from time to time.

05. This order will supersede this Ministry's order dated 04.12.2023 i.r.o. declaration of sensitive posts for rotational transfer.
