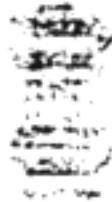
CIRCULAR

Dear *Shri Ramesh,*

Kindly recall our discussion held during your visit to FRI in the last week of March 2008 on the need to have some suitable officers of ISS cadre on deputation basis to work in ICFRE in view of ever increasing importance of statistics in forestry research and management. It is relevant to mention that in the past also ISS officers even two at a time, have worked in ICFRE on deputation. I would also like to state that we have already requested the Secretary to the Government of India, Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, New Delhi to sponsor the names of suitable ISS officers, willing to join ICFRE on deputation vide Council's letter of even number dated 26.09.2007 (copy enclosed). However, the response of the Ministry is still awaited. In our request we had clarified that the officers working in higher pay scale of Rs. 10,000-15,200, Rs. 12,000-16,500 or Rs. 14,300-18,500 could also apply and in the event of selection their pay will be protected, as per the rules or in other words, there is no restriction of pay scale for applying for the post in question.

I shall be grateful if you could kindly look into the matter personally and arrange to expedite forwarding of the names of the suitable ISS officers alongwith their bio-dta, complete CR dossiers for the last five years and vigilance clearance certificate for consideration for appointment to the post of Research Officer (Statistics) on deputation in ICFRE at the earliest.
