ORDER

The issue of assigning certain additional functions relating to the nodal statistical role of this Ministry, to the Deputy Director Generals (DDGs) of the Indian Statistical Service in the field offices of the National Sample Survey Organization {NSSO(FOD)} has been under consideration of this Ministry for quite some time. It has now been decided in consultation with the National Statistical Commission that the DDGs posted in the field offices as specified in the Annexure to this order shall, in addition to their assigned work in NSSO(FOD) will discharge the following nodal functions to assist the Central Statistical Organization (CSO) in its statistical coordination work with the State Governments and UT Administrations.

- Coordinate the sharing and flow of information between Central and the State Government / UT Administration on statistical matters.
- Coordinate with the State Government / UT Administration with regard to (ii) implementation of the decisions taken in the Conferences of Central and State Statistical Organizations.
- Coordinate with the State Government / UT Administration on the (iii) implementation of national statistical standards and data quality.
- Advise State Government / UT Administration on the implementation of all activities relating to statistics declared as 'core statistics' in the State and UT.
- Represent the Centre in the implementation of Central and Centrally (v) Sponsored Schemes on statistical matters in the State / UT.
- Represent the Central Statistical System in all Committees set up by the State Government / UT Administration on statistical matters, as requested by the State / UT.
- Assess and advice the Centre on the availability of data at State / UT level, which may be used for compilation of national level statistics.
- Assess and assist on the capacity development of the statistical system of State/ UT.
- Any other specific item of work assigned by the Chief Statistician of India. (ix)
- There will be no change in the reporting system in the NSSO(FOD) in respect 2. of the DDGs assigned with the nodal functions. However, in respect of the aforesaid nodal functions, they shall submit reports to the Chief Statistician of India periodically as may be prescribed.
