Major initiatives and achievements of the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation during June 2019

On the Statistics side, the Ministry has released monthly Index of Industrial Production (IIP) and the Consumer Price Index (CPI). The salient features of these are:

- As per the Quick Estimates (QE) of Index of Industrial Production (IIP) with base year 2011-12 released on 12th June 2019, the general index for the month of April 2019 stood at 126.8, which is 3.4% higher as compared to the level in the corresponding month of previous year.
- The General Consumer Price Indices (CPI) with base year 2012 for the month of May 2019 (provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined showed an annual inflation rate of 1.86%, 4.51% and 3.05% respectively. The Consumer Food Price Indices (CFPI) for May 2019 (provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined showed an annual inflation rate of -0.22%, 5.87% and 1.83%respectively.
- 2. Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) jointly with Indian Statistical Institute celebrated the Statistics Day 2019 on 29th June 2019 at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi. The event was inaugurated by Rao Inderjit Singh, Hon'ble Minister (I/C) of MoSPI & Ministry of Planning. Dr. Bibek Debroy, Chairman, Prime Minister's Economic Advisory Council and President, Indian Statistical Institute, Shri Pravin Srivastava, CSI-cum-Secretary, MoSPI along with senior officers of Central/State Governments and other stakeholders were present on the occasion.

The theme of Statistics Day 2019 was "Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)". The theme was chosen for intensive and focused discussions towards filling the data gaps and improvement in timelines/quality of SDGs. Dr. Subhra Sankar, Associate Professor, IIT, Kanpur was felicitated with Prof. C.R. Rao Award 2019 during the programme for his notable contribution in the field of Statistics. During the event, a short documentary film on SDGs was also exhibited reflecting country's commitment towards integrated social, economic and environmental dimensions for holistic development.

- As per the latest Review Report on the Performance of the Infrastructure Sectors for the month of April 2019, Power Generation (+5.94%), Refinery Production (+4.79%) and Upgradation of Highways by NHAI (+0.40%) exceeded their targets.
- The Sectors that fell short of their targets are Coal Production (-3.87%), Fertilizers Production (-17.58%), Crude Oil Production (-0.27%), Natural Gas Production (-0.49%), Upgradation of Highways by State PWD & Border Road Organisation (BRO) (-1.81%), Goods traffic carried by Railways (-0.27%), Export Cargo handled at Airports (-2.26%), Import Cargo handled at Airports (-15.29%), Passenger traffic handled at International terminal of the Airports (-6.82%) and Passenger traffic handled at Domestic terminal of the Airports (-15.68%).
- 4. Under MPLADS, an amount of ₹345.00 crore have been released during the Month of June 2019 and the total fund released during the financial year 2019-20 up to 30th June 2019 is ₹402.50 crore.
- 5. Status report on Minimum Government, Maximum Governance:

A new integrated MPLADS portal has been launched. This new portal provides single point of reference for all stakeholders including Members of Parliament and District Authorities. All MPLADS funds releases are being made only through PFMS & information about release of funds is uploaded on the website. The Ministry is regularly organizing training programmes for the district officials on the new website.
