## Major initiatives and achievements of the Ministry of Statistics \& Programme Implementation during August, 2022

The National Statistical Office (NSO) released Price Movement of Sub-Groups/Groups of Consumer Price Index (CPI) on Base 2012=100 for All India Rural, Urban, Combined for the month of August, 2022 (Provisional) and for the month of July, 2022 (Final) on 12th September, 2022. The General Consumer Price Indices (CPI) for the month of August, 2022 (Provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined were 175.3, 173.1 and 174.3, showing an annual inflation rate of $7.15 \%, 6.72 \%$ and $7.00 \%$ respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for July, 2022 were $6.80 \%, 6.49 \%$ and $6.71 \%$ respectively.
2. All-India Consumer Food Price Index (CFPI) for the month of August, 2022 (Provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined were 172.7, 179.5 and 175.1 respectively. All India year-on-year inflation rates for CFPI for the month of August, 2022 (Provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined sector were $7.60 \%, 7.55 \%$ and $7.62 \%$ respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for July, 2022 were 6.73\%, 6.69\%and 6.69\% respectively
3. The All-India Index of Industrial Production (IIP) for the month of July 2022 (Quick Estimates) with the base year 2011-12 has been released on $12^{\text {th }}$ September, 2022 and it stood at 134.6.
4. The Ministry has released following publications during the month:
(a) Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) Quarterly Bulletin for the Quarter April to June 2022.
(b) Annual Survey of Industry (ASI) 2019-20 final results.
(c) Payroll Reporting in India: An Employment Perspective - June, 2022.
5. A two-day study visit for delegates of Republic of Moldova to MoSPI was organized at National Statistical Systems Training Academy (NSSTA) during August 3-4, 2022.
6. Chief Statistician of India (CSI) cum Secretary, MoSPI has been re-elected as a Member and Vice Chair of Bureau during 8th Session of Committee of Statistics (CST) of United Nation Economic \& Social Commission for Asia \& Pacific (UN-ESCAP) held in Bangkok from August 23-25, 2022. A delegation led by CSI cum Secretary, MoSPI also participated in the session.
7. The major highlights of Central Sector Projects monitored under Online Computerized Monitoring System (OCMS) by this Ministry for the month of August 2022 are as under:

As per the latest Review Report on the Performance of the Infrastructure Sectors up to the month of July 2022, Power Generation ( $\mathbf{+ 1 3 . 3 5 \%}$ ), Refinery Production ( $+\mathbf{7 . 0 2}$ ), and Railways ( $+\mathbf{5 . 9 3 \%}$ ) and Passenger traffic handled at International terminal of the Airports ( $+\mathbf{0 . 8 6 \%}$ ) exceeded its targets.
9. The Sectors that fell short of their targets are Coal Production ( $-5.27 \%$ ), Fertilizers Production ( $-\mathbf{1 3 . 9 0 \%}$ ), Crude Oil Production (-2.17\%), Natural Gas Production ( $-2.80 \%$ ), Upgradation of Highways by NHAI ( $-\mathbf{1 4 . 1 1 \% ) \text { , Upgradation } , ~}$ of Highways by State PWD \& Border Road Organization(BRO) ( $\mathbf{- 2 1 . 4 8 \%}$ ), Export Cargo handled at Airports ($\mathbf{1 5 . 4 2 \%}$ ) Import Cargo handled at Airports ( $-14.96 \%$ ), and Passenger traffic handled at Domestic terminal of the Airports (-8.12\%).
