



Major initiatives and achievements of the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation during February 2020

The National Statistical Office (NSO) has released monthly Index of Industrial Production (IIP) and the Consumer Price Index (CPI). The salient features of these indices are:

- As per the Quick Estimates (QE) of Index of Industrial Production (IIP) with base year 2011-12 released on 12th February 2020, the general index for the month of December 2019 stood at 133.5, which is 0.3% lower as compared to the level in the corresponding month of previous year.
 - The General Consumer Price Indices (CPI) with base year 2012 for the month of January 2020 (provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined showed an annual inflation rate of 7.73%, 7.39% and 7.59% respectively. The Consumer Food Price Indices (CFPI) for January 2020 (provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined showed an annual inflation rate of 13.02%, 14.77% and 13.63% respectively.
2. Field work of 7th Economic Census has already going on in 31 States/UTs. Launch on 7th Economic Census for Arunachal Pradesh was commenced in February 2020.
3. Monitoring of the infrastructure sector highlighted the following:
- As per the latest Flash Report for the ongoing Central Sector Projects costing ₹150 crore and above of December 2019:

- As per the latest Review Report on the Performance of the Infrastructure Sectors for the month of December 2019, Power Generation **(+4.89%)** and refinery production **(+0.94%) exceeded** its targets.
- The Sectors that fell short of their targets are Coal Production **(-15.37%)**, Fertilizers Production **(-14.28%)**, Crude Oil Production **(-6.01%)**, Natural Gas Production **(-6.95%)**, Upgradation of Highways by NHAI **(-7.96%)**, Upgradation of Highways by State PWD & Border Road Organisation (BRO) **(-7.04%)** Goods traffic carried by Railways **(-4.70%)**, **Export** Cargo handled at Airports **(-6.29%)**, Import Cargo handled at Airports **(-15.39%)**, Passenger traffic handled at International terminal of the Airports **(-4.65%)** and Passenger traffic handled at Domestic terminal of the Airports **(-8.14%)**.

4. Under MPLADS, an amount of ₹ **387.50** crore have been released during the Month of February 2020 and the total fund released during the financial year 2019-20 up to **29th February 2020** is ₹ **3242.50 crore**.
