Major initiatives and achievements of the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation during July, 2022

The National Statistical Office (NSO) released Price Movement of Sub-Groups/Groups of Consumer Price Index (CPI) on Base 2012=100 for All India Rural, Urban, Combined for the month of July, 2022 (Provisional) and for the month of June, 2022 (Final) on 12th August, 2022. The General Consumer Price Indices (CPI) for the month of July, 2022 (Provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined were 174.3, 172.3 and 173.4, showing an annual inflation rate of 6.80%, 6.49% and 6.71% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for June, 2022 were 7.09%, 6.86% and 7.01% respectively.

2. All-India Consumer Food Price Index (CFPI) for the month of **July, 2022 (Provisional)** for Rural, Urban and Combined were 171.3, 178.6 and 173.9 respectively. All India year-on-year inflation rates for CFPI for the month of **July, 2022(Provisional)** for Rural, Urban and Combined sector were 6.80%, 6.69% and 6.75% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for **June, 2022** were 7.61%, 8.04% and 7.75% respectively.

3. The All-India Index of Industrial Production (IIP) for the month of **June 2022** (Quick Estimates) with the base year 2011-12 has been released on 12th August, 2022 and it stood at 137.9.

4. During the month of July 2022, Ministry has released Payroll Reporting in India: An Employment Perspective - May, 2022.

5. The major highlights of Central Sector Projects monitored under Online Computerized Monitoring System (OCMS) by this Ministry for the month of **July 2022** are as under:

6. As per the latest Review Report on the Performance of the Infrastructure Sectors up to the month of June 2022, Power Generation (+15.29%), Natural Gas Production (+5.64%) and Railways (+7.14%) exceeded its targets.

7. The Sectors that fell short of their targets are Coal Production (-6.10%) Fertilizers Production (-13.02%), Crude Oil Production (-1.00%), Refinery Production (-2.63%), Upgradation of Highways by NHAI (-22.64%), Upgradation of Highways by State PWD & Border Road Organization (BRO) (-27.69%), Export Cargo handled at Airports (-12.60%) Import Cargo handled at Airports (-18.17%), Passenger traffic handled at International terminal of the Airports (-2.76%) and Passenger traffic handled at Domestic terminal of the Airports (-5.46%).
