Major initiatives and achievements of the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation during May 2022

The National Statistical Office (NSO) released Price Movement of Sub-Groups / Groups of Consumer Price Index (CPI) on Base 2012=100 for All India Rural, Urban, Combined for the month of May 2022 (Provisional) and for the month of April 2022 (Final) on 13thJune, 2022. The General Consumer Price Indices (CPI) for the month of May, 2022 (Provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined were 172.4, 170.8 and 171.7, showing an annual inflation rate of 7.01%, 7.08% and 7.04% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for April, 2022 were 8.38%, 7.09% and 7.79% respectively.

- 2. All-India Consumer Food Price Index (CFPI) for the month of May, 2022 (Provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined were 169.5, 176.8 and 172.1 respectively. All India year-on-year inflation rates for CFPI for the month of May, 2022 (Provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined sector were 7.76%, 8.20% and 7.97% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for April, 2022 were 8.50%, 8.09% and 8.31% respectively.
- 3. The All-India Index of Industrial Production (IIP) for the month of **April 2022** (Quick Estimates) with the base year 2011-12 has been released on 10th June, 2022 and it stood at 135.1.
- 4. India has been re-elected to the Governing Council of the UN Statistical Institute for Asia and the Pacific, Japan for the term 2022-2025.
- 5. During the month of May 2022, Ministry has released following Pay Roll/Press Note/Provisional results:
 - (i) Payroll Reporting in India: An Employment Perspective March, 2022 released on 25th May, 2022.
 - (ii) Press Note on Provisional Estimates of Annual National Income 2021-22 and Quarterly Estimates Fourth Quarter (Q4) of GDP of 2021-22 on 31st May, 2022.
 - (iii) Provisional results of Annual Survey of Industries (ASI) 2019-20.
- 6. The major highlights of Central Sector Projects monitored under Online Computerized Monitoring System (OCMS) by this Ministry for the month of **May 2022** are as under:

- 7. As per the latest Review Report on the Performance of the Infrastructure Sectors up to the month of April 2022, Power Generation (+15.68%), Crude Oil Production (+3.32%), Refinery Production (+2.62%) and Railways (+6.49%), exceeded its targets.
- 8. The Sectors that fell short of their targets are Coal Production (-8.17%) Fertilizers Production (-18.69%), Natural Gas Production (-5.85%), Upgradation of Highways by NHAI (-36.65%), Upgradation of Highways by State PWD & Border Road Organization(BRO) (-31.39%), Export Cargo handled at Airports (-12.41%), Import Cargo handled at Airports (-17.01%), Passenger traffic handled at International terminal of the Airports (-14.42%) and Passenger traffic handled at Domestic terminal of the Airports (-7.84%).
