Major initiatives and achievements of the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation during October, 2021

The Expenditure Finance Committee (EFC) considered the proposal of the Ministry in its meeting held on 08-10-2021 for the continuation of Capacity Development Scheme (Central Sector Scheme) and recommended the continuation of the Scheme with an outlay of Rs. 3179.45 Crore for the period 2021-26.

- 2. The Cabinet in its meeting held on 10-11-2021 approved the proposal of the Ministry for restoration of MPLADS for the remaining period of 2021-22 and continuation of MPLADS for the period up to 2025-26 with an outlay of Rs. 17417.00 crore.
- 3. The 13th Meeting of Heads of BRICS National Statistical Offices (NSOs) was held on 28th October, 2021 in virtual mode. The meeting was chaired by India (me) and attended by the representatives of the National Statistical Offices (NSOs) of BRICS Countries. The Joint Statistical Publication (JSP) 2021 and JSP Snapshot 2021 for BRICS Countries were released during the meeting. The meeting was coordinated by the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India.
- 4. The Ministry released Price Movement of Sub-Groups/Groups of Consumer Price Index (CPI) on Base 2012=100 for All India Rural, Urban, Combined for the month of October, 2021 (Provisional) and for the month of September, 2021 (Final) on 12th November 2021. The General Consumer Price Indices (CPI) for the month of October, 2021 (Provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined were 166.3, 164.6 and 165.5, showing an annual inflation rate of 4.07%, 5.04% and 4.48% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for September, 2021 were 4.13%, 4.57% and 4.35% respectively.
- 5. All-India Consumer Food Price Index (CFPI) for the month of October, 2021 (Provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined were 164.4, 171.3 and 166.9 respectively. All India year-on-year inflation rates for CFPI for the month of October, 2021 for Rural, Urban and Combined sector were 0.31%, 1.72% and 0.85% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for September, 2021 were 0.69%, 0.67% and 0.68% respectively.
- 6. The all-India Index of Industrial Production (IIP) for the month of **September**, **2021** (Quick Estimates) with base year 2011-12 released on 12th November, 2021 and it stood at 127.9.
- 7. The Ministry released the Press Note on Payroll Reporting in India: An Employment Perspective August, 2021.

- 9. As per the latest Review Report on the Performance of the Infrastructure Sectors up to the month of September 2021, Power Generation (+10.55%), Import Cargo handled at Airports (+19.12%), Passenger traffic handled at International terminal of the Airports (+32.94%) and Passenger traffic handled at Domestic terminal of the Airports (+4.86%) exceeded its targets.
- 10. The Sectors that fell short of their targets are Coal Production (-12.39%), Fertilizers Production (-18.70%), Crude Oil Production (-3.68%), Refinery Production (-3.18%), Natural Gas Production (-6.74%), Upgradation of Highways by NHAI (-14.58%), Upgradation of Highways by State PWD & Border Road Organization (BRO) (-5.08%), Railways (-0.64%), and Export Cargo handled at Airports (-3.63%).
