Major initiatives and achievements of the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation during August, 2020

The National Statistical Office (NSO) released Price Movement of Sub-Groups/Groups of Consumer Price Index (CPI) on **Base 2012=100** for All India Rural, Urban, Combined for the month of July, 2020 (Provisional) on August 13, 2020.

- 2. As various pandemic related restrictions were gradually lifted and non-essential activities started resuming operations, the data availability improved considerably compared to months of April and May, 2020. As a result, the final indices for the month of June, 2020 and provisional indices for the month of July, 2020 could be compiled for All India as well as State level after two months. The General Consumer Price Indices (CPI) for the month of July, 2020 (Provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined were 155.1, 153.1 and 154.2, showing an annual inflation rate of 7.04%, 6.84% and 6.93% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for June, 2020 were 6.34%, 6.12% and 6.23% respectively.
- 2.1 All-India Consumer Food Price Index (CFPI) was released for the month of **July**, **2020**. The corresponding figures for Rural, Urban and Combined are 155.5, 160.2 and 157.2 respectively. All India year-on-year inflation rates for CFPI for the month of **July**, **2020** for Rural, Urban and Combined sector are 9.89%, 9.05% and 9.62% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for **June**, **2020** were 8.84%, 8.58% and 8.72% respectively.
- 3. The Index of Industrial Production (IIP) for the month of June, 2020 was released on August 11, 2020. This was with base year 2011-12. The IIP for the month of June, 2020 stood at 107.8.
- 4. The fieldwork and supervision of 7th Economic Census (EC) was accelerated across 35 States/ UTs during the month. As on 31.08.2020, 26.11 Cr surveys have been completed which is approximately 84% of the target surveys originally estimated for these States/ UTs.
- 4.1 Consultation with State/ UT Governments has been initiated for resolving various operational issues and discussing provisional results from the 7th EC data collected thus far. During August, 2020, five webinars were conducted with senior officials of 16 State/ UT Governments.
- The 7th Session of Committee of Statistics of the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (UNESCAP) was held during 26-28, August 2020 through virtual platform with participation of the member countries including Indian delegation led by CSI and Secretary MoSPI. India was jointly elected along with Sri Lanka (on sharing basis) as vice-chair for the Bureau of UN- ESCAP Committee on Statistics for the years 2020-22. India is to hold the post for the first of two year term.

- 6.3 As per the latest Review Report on the Performance of the Infrastructure Sectors up to the month of June, 2020, Upgradation of Highways by State PWD & Border Road Organisation (BRO) (+78.09%), Export Cargo handled at Airports (+9.96%), Import Cargo handled at Airports (+8.46%) and Passenger Traffic handled at International terminal of the Airports (+31.45%) exceeded targets.
- 6.4 The sectors that fell short of their targets were Power Generation (-12.07%), Coal Production (-22.50%), Fertilizers Production (-10.58%), Crude Oil Production (-3.04%), Refinery Production (-20.22%) Natural Gas Production (-11.12%), Upgradation of Highways by NHAI (-16.60%) and Passenger Traffic handled at Domestic terminals of the Airports (-28.80%).
