Major initiatives and achievements of the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation during April, 2021

Keeping in view the threat to human life posed by the second wave of COVID-19 pandemic, the Ministry decided to extend the one-time dispensation granted earlier on 24.03.2020 for the FY 2020-21 under MPLADS for purchase of testing, screening and other facilities in connection with COVID-19. It has also been decided to allow setting-up of independent oxygen manufacturing plants in Government Hospitals/Dispensaries as a one-time measure till the end of FY 2021-22 or further orders, whichever is earlier to solve the oxygen shortage problem at each District of the Country.

- 2. The National Statistical Office (NSO) released Price Movement of Sub-Groups/Groups of Consumer Price Index (CPI) on **Base 2012=100** for All India Rural, Urban, Combined for the month of April, 2021 (Provisional) and for the month of March, 2020 (Final) on 12th May, 2021.
- 3. The General Consumer Price Indices (CPI) for the month of **April, 2021** (Provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined were 157.7, 158.1 and 157.9, showing an annual inflation rate of 3.82%, 4.77% and 4.29% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for **March, 2021** were 4.61%, 6.52% and 5.52% respectively.
- 4. All-India Consumer Food Price Index (CFPI) for the month of **April, 2021** (Provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined were 154.3, 160.6 and 156.5 respectively. All India year-on-year inflation rates for CFPI for the month of **April, 2021** for Rural, Urban and Combined sector were 1.45%, 3.15% and 2.02% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for **March, 2021** were 3.94%, 6.64% and 4.87% respectively.
- 5. The all-India Index of Industrial Production (IIP) with base 2011-12 for the month of **March, 2021** (Quick Estimates) was released on 12th May 2021 and stands at 143.4 with a growth rate of 22.4 percent as compared to March 2020.
- 6. Fieldwork for the 7th Economic Census (EC) has been completed in 34 States/UTs. In view of challenges posed by second wave of COVID-19 pandemic and consequent restrictions on movements, etc., EC field work is suspended in few pockets of A&N Islands and Ladakh. As on 30.04.2021, more than 40.4 Crore surveys of Economic Establishments and Households have been conducted under the 7th EC across the country.

7. The major highlights of Central Sector Projects costing Rs. 150 crores and above monitored under Online Computerized Monitoring System (OCMS) by this Ministry for the month of **April**, **2021** are as under:

As per the latest Review Report on the Performance of the Infrastructure Sectors up to the month of March 2021, Power Generation (+3.89%), Upgradation of Highways by State PWD & Border Road Organization(BRO) (+53.46%), Export Cargo handled at Airports (+18.29%) and Import Cargo handled at Airports (+39.42%) exceeded its targets.
- 9. The Sectors that fell short of their targets are Coal Production (-13.61%), Fertilizers Production (-12.50%), Crude Oil Production (-5.65%), Refinery Production (-11.88%), Natural Gas Production (-14.60%), Upgradation of Highways by NHAI (-7.70%), Railways (-2.68%), Passenger traffic handled at International terminal of the Airports (-59.49%) and Passenger traffic handled at Domestic terminal of the Airports (-39.86%).
