Major initiatives and achievements of the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation during December, 2020

- 1. National Statistics Office (NSO) released the Price Movement of Sub-Groups/Groups of Consumer Price Index (CPI) on Base 2012=100 for All India Rural, Urban, Combined for the month of December, 2020 (Provisional) and for the month of November, 2020 (Final) on 12th January, 2021. Price data are collected from selected 1114 urban markets and 1181 villages by the Field Operations Division of NSO, MoSPI in a uniform weekly roaster. The General Consumer Price Indices (CPI) for the month of December, 2020 (Provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined were 158.5, 156.0 and 157.3, showing an annual inflation rate of 4.07%, 5.19% and 4.59% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for November, 2020 were 7.20%, 6.73% and 6.93% respectively.
- 2. All-India Consumer Food Price Index (CFPI) for the month of **December**, **2020** (Provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined were 159.1, 163.4 and 160.6 respectively. All India year-on-year inflation rates for CFPI for the month of **December**, **2020** for Rural, Urban and Combined sector were 3.11%, 4.08% and 3.41% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for **November**, **2020** were 9.64%, 9.23% and 9.50% respectively.
- 3. The Index of Industrial Production (IIP) for the month of November, 2020 was released on 12th January, 2021 and it stands at 126.3.
- 4. Fieldwork of 7th Economic Census (EC) is nearing completion in most of the States and UTs. As on 31.12.2020, more than 36.87 Crore surveys have been completed by the Implementing Agency. Provisional results (on data collected thus far) have been shared with States / UTs for their comments, etc. During December, 2020, total 11 webinars with senior officials of 13 State/ UT Governments were conducted to resolve their operational issues and data finalization.
- 5. The highlights of the Central Sector Projects costing Rs.150 crores and above monitored under Online Computerized Monitoring System (OCMS) by this Ministry for the month of December, 2020 are as under:

- 6. In the month of **November 2020**, out of 11 infrastructure sectors monitored by this Ministry, the performance of Power Generation (+0.24%), up-gradation of Highways by State PWD & Border Road Organization (BRO) (+50.43%), Export Cargo handled at Airports (+20.71%) and Import Cargo handled at Airports (+34.57%) **exceeded its targets.**
- 7. The Sectors that **fell short of their targets** in the month of **November 2020** are Coal Production (-22.55%), Fertilizers Production (-10.64%), Crude Oil Production (-5.28%), Refinery Production (-15.95%), Natural Gas Production (-14.79%), Upgradation of Highways by NHAI (-11.07%), Railways (-7.70%), Passenger Traffic handled at International Terminal of the Airports (-51.10%) and Passenger Traffic handled at Domestic Terminal of the Airports (-42.47%).

Major initiatives and achievements of the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation during November, 2020

- 1. The National Statistical Office (NSO), Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation released Price Movement of Sub-Groups / Groups of Consumer Price Index (CPI) on Base 2012=100 for All India Rural, Urban, Combined for the month of November 2020 (provisional) and for the month of October 2020 (Final) on 14th December 2020. Price data are collected from selected 1114 urban markets and 1181 villages by the Field Operations Division of NSO, MoSPI in a uniform weekly roaster. The General Consumer Price Indices (CPI) for the month of November 2020 (Provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined were 160.7, 156.9 and 158.9, showing an annual inflation rate of 7.20%. 6.73% and 6.93% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for October 2020 were 7.75% 7.33% and 7.61% respectively.
- 2. All-India Consumer Food Price Index (CFPI) for the month of **November 2020** (Provisional) for Rural, Urban and Combined were 164.8, 167.8 and 165.9 respectively. All India year-on-year inflation rates for CFPI for the month of **November, 2020** (**Provisional**) for Rural, Urban and Combined sector were 9.57%, 9.10% and 9.43% respectively. The corresponding inflation rates (Final) for Rural, Urban and Combined for **October, 2020** were 11.12%, 10.86% and 11.00% respectively.
- 3. The Index of Industrial Production (IIP) for the month of October 2020 was released on 11th December 2020. The IIP for the month of October 2020 stood at 128.5.
- 4. Fieldwork of 7th Economics Census (EC) is going on in 35 States / UTs and is nearing completion in most State/ UTs. As on 29.11.2020, more than 33.17 crore household surveys have been completed by the Implementing Agency. Provisional Results (on data collected thus far) have been shared with State/UTs for their comments, etc. During November' 2020, total 16 webinars with senior officials of 19 State / UT Governments were conducted for, inter-alia, discussing for data finalization of 7th EC and Operational issues faced by State / UTs.
- 5. Two workshops on Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) State Indicator Framework (SIF) and Global Indices covering 18 States/UTs were conducted on 24th and 26th November, 2020 with the objective to assess the status of monitoring of SDGs at Sub-National level through monitoring framework(s) and to provide suggestions for further course of action.
- 6. A two-day 'EnviStats India GIS Webinar' was organised on 26-27 November, 2020 to sensitize the users about the role of GIS datasets in compilation of environment accounts. Since the first day of the event, i.e. 26th November 2020, coincided with the country's 'Constitution Day', the event was also used to create awareness of the fundamental duty of every citizen 'to protect and improve the natural environment'.
- 7. The time lag of generating Reports on Central Infrastructure Projects has been reduced from 45 days to 15 days. As result of which, the highlights of the infrastructure sectors project of

the country monitored under Online Computerized Monitoring System (OCMS) for the month of October, 2020 and November 2020 are as under.

- 7.2 In the month of **October 2020**, the up gradation of highways by state PWD & Border Road Organization (BRO) (+24.48%), Export Cargo handled at Airports (+21.07%) and Import Cargo handled at Airports (+31.56%) exceeded its targets.
- 7.3 However the Sectors that fell short of their targets are Power Generation (-0.45%), Coal Production (-23.38%), Fertilizers Production (-10.83%), Crude Oil Production (-5.00%), refinery production (-18.41%), Natural Gas Production (-13.90%), Up gradation of Highways by NHAI (-25.72%), Railways (-9.18%), Passenger traffic handled at International terminal of the Airports (-43.65%) and Passenger traffic handled at Domestic terminal of the Airports (-43.25%).
