Tables with Notes on Capital Formation

The report entitled 'Tables with Notes on Capital Formation (Urban), NSS 17th Round, September 1961—July 1962' was prepared by the Indian Statistical Institute and it is being published in form in which it was submitted to the Government of India. The views contained in the report are not necessarily those of the Government of India.*

CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The National Sample Survey Organisation in its seventeenth round provided for collection of data on some items of fixed assets to throw light on the extent of capital formation by the household sector in urban India on an exploratory basis. Similar data for the rural areas were collected in the fifteenth round (July 1959—June 1960) and presented in the National Sample Survey Report No. 97. The Survey in the seventeenth round was conducted from September, 1961 to July. 1962 and the results are presented in these 'tables with notes'.
- 1.2 The geographical coverage of the survey included the whole of India except the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Amindivi, Laccadive and Minicoy Islands, the Ladakh district of Jammu and Kashmir the disturbed area of Manipur and the North East Frontier Agency.
- 1.3 Information was collected by the interview method. The responsibility for field work was with the Directorate of the National Sample Survey of the Government of India in all the states and union territories except in West Bengal and the Bombay city where the field work was done by the staff of the Indian Statistical Institute. Processing and tabulation of data were done in the Indian Statistical Institute.
- 1.4 All the states except West Begal and Mysore which had joined the NSS by the seventeenth round on matching sample basis participated in this enquiry also. The estimates presented in these tables are based on central samples only. 13343 sample households from 2225 sample blocks were chosen under the techniques of Interpenetrating Net Work of Samples (IPNS) and the estimates are given by independent and interpenetrating sub-samples and also by the combined samples.

ITEM COVERAGE

- 1.5 Information on fixed capital assets used in enterprises by the households was cellected and no account of the change in stocks of working capital had been taken in the schedules of enquiry. Though expenditure on purchase of used assets is capital transfer and does not add to national capital formation, the transference of such used assets from non-enterprise use to enterprise use has to be taken into account. It is for this reason that used assets have been separately included in this survey. The broad items on which data were collected are:
 - (i) construction and improvements of buildings and other structures for residential and non-residential purposes;
 - (ii) land development;
 - (iii) new physical assets for use in (a) agriculture and in (b) enterprises other than agriculture, like tools and implements, machinery, transport equipments, furniture and other assets;
 - (iv) improvements on used assets for enterprise purposes;
 - (v) transactions (sale and purchase) on used physical assets meant for use in (a) agriculture and in (b) enterprises other than agriculture;
 - (vi) new and used physical assets for domestic use;
 - (vii) change in livestock; and
 - (viii) source of finance.
- 1.6 For purposes of this enquiry, expenditure approach was followed and the reference period was one year preceding the date of enquiry. Expenditure incurred by the household enterprises by way of purchase, construction and improvements on physical assets for own use and not meant for sale within the reference period was required to be recorded. In regard to purchase of physical assets the distinction between new and used ones was maintained. These assets included land, buildings and other structures, tools and implements, machinery, transport equipments, power generating equipments, furniture and fittings and any other fixed assets.
- 1.7 For purposes of collection of data the household enterprises were divided only between (i) agriculture, and (ii) enterprises other than agriculture. Apart from this data were also collected separately on expenditure over the assets purely for domestic use by the households.

- 1.8 The usual NSS definition of the household, i.e., a group of persons usually living together and taking principal meals from the same kitchen was followed for this enquiry also.
- 1.9 Purchase value of physical assets included transport and installation charges, brokerage and any other incidental expenses.
- 1.10 In connection with construction and improvement works apart from the value of purchased materials and hired labour charges the imputed value, at the prevailing market rate, of materials supplied from home and the household labour was recorded.
- 1.11 Land development was defined as improving the productive capacity of land or as increasing the usefulness of land through construction or improvment works. Construction for land development meant raising or levelling of land, fencing, bunding, measures for reclamation of waste lands, laying plantations, construction of ponds, wells, tubewells, canales, ditches and other irrigation devices. Improvements under land development meant bettering the conditions of any such items mentioned above.
- 1.12 In the case of buildings and other structures construction meant addition to fleer space and betterment of these structures was covered under improvements. Major repairs which were supposed to extend the life of the building were considered as improvements.
- 1.13 Buildings and other structures for non-residential use were considered to be those meant for household enterprises, or for any religious and charitable activities.
- 1.14 If construction and improvements either for land development or for buildings and other structures or for any other physical assets were not complete within the reference period, that part of expenditure which had actually entered the reference period was taken into account, expenditure having been made either in the form of cash or kind or credit.
- 1.15 The value of land was required to be shown separately from the purchase price of building and other structures.

CHAPTER II

SUMMARY OF RESULTS

- 2.1 The enquiry on capital formation in the urban household sector covering 13343 sample households within 2225 sample blocks during the seventeenth round of the NSS (September 1961—July 1962) revealed that about 9.6 percent of households reported expenditure on items included for capital formation purposes (table 1.1). These items are land development purchase and construction of new buildings and other structures, new tools and implements, machinery, transport equipments and other fixed assets along with improvements of buildings and other used assets for own use by the enterprises. With households engaged in such capital formation as base the percentage distribution of households making expenditure on different items for all-India is: land development-6.9, construction and imporvements of buildings and other structures—67.5, purchase of new buildings-1.3, new physical assets for use in agriculture-8.8 and new physical assets for use in other enterprises-20.0 (table 1.1).
- 2.2 Per household expenditure with respect to households reporting expenditure on items included for capital formation purposes during the reference period of one year as shown in table 2.1 is: land development-Rs. 74.8, construction & improvements of buildings and other structures-Rs. 484.8, purchase of new buildings and other structures-Rs. 42.3, new physical assets for use in agriculture-Rs. 19.0, new physical assets for use in other enterprises-Rs.163.3.
- 2.3 Moreover table 2.1 shows that in the agricultural enterprises purchase of used assets and of land accounted for Rs. 9.8 and Rs. 25.1 respectively while for other enterprises these items stood at Rs. 410.5 and Rs. 3.7 respectively. Assets formation for domestic use was valued at about Rs. 123.0 for new assets, Rs. 32.7 for used assets and Rs. 24.6 for land per reporting household.
- 2.4 The schedule had provided for improvements on used assets and about 2.3 lakhs household reported their having been engaged in such type of work and their average outlay during the one year reference period stood at Rs. 49.7 and Rs. 442.9 in the agricultural sector and in the other enterprises sector respectively (table 7.1), was valued at about Rs. 200 for new assets, Rs. 42 for used assets and Rs. 25 for land per reporting household.
- 2.5 Looking through further breakdown in table (3.1) it may be observed that in the reporting households the share between construction and improvements of buildings and other structure was Rs. 399.6 and Rs. 85.2 respectively and only Rs. 28.4 of total investments on these items was for non-residential puposes.
- 2.6 Per household expenditure amounting to Rs. 192.2 on new assets by the household enterprises was divided between purchase and construction as Rs. 186.7 and 5.5 repectively. (table 5.1).
- 2.7 Change in the value of livestock since one year showed an increase in the value by Rs. 6.62 per household (table no. 8.1) on the basis of all estimated households).
- 2.8 Of the total investments by the households about 70 percent came from personal savings and over 22 percent came from borrowing. Almost similar percentage distribution of sources of finance for construction and improvements of buildings and other structures was observed (table 9.2).

APPENDIX I

SAMPLING DESIGN AND ESTIMATION PROCEDURE

A.1.1. The enquiry on capital formation in the household sector of the urban areas was conducted through the integrated sampling design of the seventeenth round of the NSS (urban), September 1961 to July 1962, with due weightage to households engaged in construction activities and in the accumulation of productive physical assets. It was a stratified two-stage sampling design where the first stage units were the urban blocks and the second stage units were the households. The samples had been selected in the form of three independent sub-samples. All-India urban area was divided into two sectors—sector I, consisting of towns and cities with 1951 census population of 50 thousand or above and sector 2, consisting of the remaining urban areas. Each state within a sector formed a stratum. Thus all the states had two strata each. But only Maharashtra had three strata, one additional strata being formed with Bombay City itself. The total number of strata was thirty-five. Sample blocks were allocated to each of the sectors, sector 1 and sector 2, in proportion of 2:1 to give more weightage to sector 1 towns. The allocation to the states within each sector was in proportion to their urban population in that sector and was modified taking into account the available investigator strength and finally rounded off to multiples of 18.

SELECTION OF BLOCKS

A.1.2. In each stratum of sector 1, three samples of one third the number of blocks allotted were selected systematically with an independent random start. The frame for selection was the list of blocks prepared by the NSS in the Urban Frame Survey (UFS). In each stratum of sector 2, towns were arranged by regions and within them by the distribution of their 1951 Census population in different livelihood classes. Three independent systematic samples of towns of one third the sample size allotted to each stratum were selected with probability proportional to the number of 1951 census blocks. Within each selected town, the UFS list of blocks or in its absence, the 1961 census list of blocks was used and one block was selected with equal probability. If the size of the block was too large artificial blocks were created which were generally compact, indentifiable and of equal population content.

WEIGHTAGE

A.1.3. With a view to giving due weightage to households in a block engaged in acquisition and construction of physical assets, the households were stratified into three second stage strata, viz., (i) those reporting capital formation in buildings and other structures, (ii) those reporting other capital formation, and (iii) the rest of households. A circular systematic samples of sizes 2, 3 and 1 were drawn from strata (i), (ii) and (iii) respectively.

WORK PROGRAMME

A.1.4. The survey period of 11 months (September 1961 to July 1962) was divided into 6 sub-rounds each of 8 weeks duration and each sample block was visited, listed and surveyed twice at an interval of nearly 3 sub-rounds for socio-economic enquiries of the NSS. Each sub-round was divided into two halves within each of which three specified sample blocks for specified schedules were required to be completed. In case the work remained incomplete that was required to be completed in the next sub-round along with the work of that sub-round. The Capital Formation enquiry was conducted in the second half of the first three sub-rounds and in the first half of the next three sub-rounds.

A.1.5. The sampling design and work programme for the participating states were the same as those for the central samples.

ESTIMATION PROCEDURE

A.1.6. Let T stand for the estimate of the state total of the concerned characteristic in the corresponding schedule as obtained from a particular sub-sample for the sub-round. For Maharashtra state, the total was obtained by summing over the three sectors 0, 1 and 2 whereas for all the other states summation was over the sectors of 1 and 2 only. Then we have,
