


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

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## CONCEPTS AND DEFINITIONS

**2.1 Definition of a household.**—A *de jure* concept was adopted, and a household was considered to consist of its normal resident members only and births and deaths occurring to these members, whatever be the place of occurrence were recorded. Persons who normally pass nights under the same roof and take food from the same kitchen, irrespective of the immediate length of stay in the household, were considered as normally resident members in the household. Normally resident members thus exclude guests but include temporary absentees. The decision as to whether a particular person would be treated as a normally resident member in a household was left to the informant, the judgement of the investigator being exercised to know that a person is (a) not claimed to be a normally resident member in more than one household or (b) not omitted in all households : a person to be considered a normally resident member in a household should not have formed a separate household or joined, as a usual member, another household. Thus, a student residing in a hostel who has normal place of residence somewhere else is excluded from the hostel and included in the normal place of residence, but orphans residing in a hostel and without any other places of residence are included in the hostel. Casual patients at hospital are excluded, not the permanent patients. The count of populations was on a *de facto* basis only for the floating population without any normal residence who were looked for and counted in the place where they were found at the time of investigation.

**2.2 Single member and extinct (by death) households.**—Instruction was given specifically to seek for and count single member households and also extinct households which ceased to exist because of the deaths of all the members during the preceding two years as these are left out from the frame : a particular case is that of extinct single member household consequent on the death of lone member. It should be noted that if the frame consists of the extant households only, the population would refer to that obtaining on the date of survey and would, by definition, exclude households which ceased to exist consequent on the death of all the members. Information on such households was sought from the neighbours and responsible persons; enquiry was also made in every tenth household surveyed. In this setting, the chance of omission of such households is likely to be small. The number of such households reported in the enquiry is, however, small.

### Vital Rates

**2.3** The events of births and deaths in the household were recorded with the date of occurrence during the reference period of two years preceding the date of survey; and only those for the year preceding the date of survey have been taken into account for the calculation of the annual vital rates presented in this report. The reference ("recall") period, the 365 days preceding the date of survey, was a moving one as the survey period was spread over time. Thus, the results presented do not refer to a fixed time period but refer to the overlapping time period of length of one year, spread over the survey period : this method, as has been explained in NSS Report Number 48, is aimed at minimising omissions in reporting due to recall lapse. In the calculation of birth and death rates, the *current* population has been taken as the base. These rates would not, therefore, be strictly comparable with rates calculated with the mid-year population as the base. The rate of growth of population in this report is the balance of births over deaths.

**2.4** In calculating the age specific fertility rates, the total number of live-births born to the mothers of a particular age-group has been divided by the total female population of that particular age-group and the result has been expressed per 1000 such females.

**2.5** In calculating the per capita monthly household expenditure specific birth rates, the total number of live-births born to the mothers of a particular per capita monthly household expenditure has been divided by the total population of the same per capita monthly household expenditure class and the result has been expressed per 1000 such population. The household occupation specific birth rate has been obtained in the same way.

**2.6** The infant mortality rate has been calculated by relating the number of children dying before attaining one year of life to the total number of children born alive in the last year and the result has been expressed per 1000 live-births.

**2.7** Age specific death rates have been obtained on dividing the number of deaths of a particular age-group by the total population in that age-group and the result has been expressed per 1000 population. The age-specific rates have been calculated separately for males and females as well as for both sexes combined.

**2.8** The per capita monthly household expenditure specific death rates have been obtained on dividing the number of deaths to persons of a particular per capita monthly household expenditure class by the total population of the same per capita monthly household expenditure class and the result has been expressed per 1000 persons. The household occupation specific death rate has been obtained in the same manner.

**2.9** Sex-ratio at birth is the number of male births per 100 female births.

**2.10** Non-occurrence of vital events in any cell has been indicated by the symbol ‘—’.

### CHAPTER THREE

#### SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

3.0 This chapter gives the results of the enquiry on population, births and deaths carried out in the 16th round (July 1960—August 1961) of the NSS in urban areas in India. Results of the later rounds already available in the earlier NSS report have been included for purposes of comparison. The estimates of various population characteristics are generally presented sub-sample-wise so that some idea of the margin of uncertainty could be obtained.

3.1 *Rates of birth, deaths and natural increase.*—The rates of births, deaths and natural increase in the urban areas of India are presented in Table (3.1) below. During the sixteenth round the birth rate is found to be 33/1000 persons. However, during the period 1961-65 the rate has declined from 34/1000 in the seventeenth round to 32/1000 in the eighteenth and nineteenth rounds. The death rate has remained almost stationary (8/1000 persons) from the sixteenth round to the nineteenth round resulting in the decline of the rate of natural increase in the eighteenth and nineteenth rounds.

3.2 *Rates of births, deaths and natural increase by population size-classes.*—Table (3.2) presents the births and deaths rates and the rate of natural increase in two population size-classes of towns, towns with population 50,000 and above and towns with population below 50,000. It is seen that in the higher size class of towns the rates of births, deaths and natural increase are markedly lower than those of the small size class of towns. The differences observed between the two size classes of towns may partly be explained by the different age-sex composition of the population in the two groups of towns.

3.3 *Age-specific fertility rates.*—The fertility rates by age of mother in the urban areas based on the sixteenth round data are presented in Table (3.3). The rural fertility rates by age of mother based on fourteenth round (July 1958–June 1959) have also been presented in the same table. Although the fertility rates of the two areas do not relate to the same calendar period, these, however, would give fairly good indication of the fertility differentials between the rural and urban areas. The fertility pattern in the urban areas is more or less similar to that of the rural areas but the urban fertility rate in each age group is considerably lower than its rural counterpart. In both the areas the fertility rate reaches maximum in the age-group 20-24, the rural and urban rates being 263.6 and 244.7/1000 females respectively and then decreases gradually with the increase of age of mother.

3.4 Table (3.3) also presents the age-specific fertility rates of England & Wales. In England & Wales the fertility rate of women under 20 years is very low compared with the Indian women of the corresponding age; the relatively high fertility in India in the above age-group is mainly due to lower age at marriage. In England & Wales the fertility rate reaches maximum (176.5/1000 females) in the age-group 25-29 and then declines gradually with the increasing age of mother while in India it reaches maximum in the age-group 20-24 and then falls gradually with the increasing age of mother. The general fertility rate of India, it is seen from the table, is almost twice as that of England & Wales.

3.5 Birth rates by per capita household expenditure classes.—The annual birth rates have been analysed by per capita monthly household expenditure classes and have been presented in Table (3.4) along with the results of NSS 17th round. In the sixteenth round it is observed that the birth rate is high among the less affluent classes and falls with increasing per capita monthly household expenditures. The fertility rates in different per capita household expenditure classes in the NSS 16th and 17th rounds are generally found to be in agreement.

3.6 Birth rates by household occupational groups.—The birth rates among different household occupations groups are presented in Table (3.5). The birth rate is found to be highest, 37.8/1000 persons, among the transport and related workers followed by craftsmen and production process workers (36.1/1000) and agricultural workers (35.0/1000). Among the administrative and executive workers the birth rate is the lowest, 28.1/1000 persons, with professional and technical workers coming second, 30.5/1000 persons.

**3.7 Age-specific mortality rates by sex.**—The age specific death rates per 1000 population by sex have been presented in Table (3.6) for all-India urban. The death rate starts at a high level in the first year of life, then falls sharply and attains minimum in the age-group 10-14 in case of females and in the age-group 15-19 in case of males, then moves up slowly in the middle ages and finally rises rapidly in the older ages. The age-specific death rates for males are found to be higher in the first year of life and beyond age-group 35-39 while higher females mortality is observed in all the age-groups upto 35-39 excepting the first year of life. It is also seen that the mortality is more or less same for either sex.

**3.8 Mortality rates by per capita households expenditure.**—The mortality rates in different per capita monthly household expenditure classes are presented in Table (3.7) along with the results of the seventeenth round. It is seen that the mortality rate in the first four classes of per capita monthly household expenditure ranges from 8 to 9 per 1000 persons in the sixteenth round and then, it generally declines with the increasing per capita monthly household expenditure, the mortality rate being 4/1000 in the highest expenditure class. The agreement between the mortality rates for different per capita monthly household expenditure classes in the sixteenth and seventeenth rounds is found to be generally good.

**3.9 Mortality rates by household occupational groups.**—Table (3.8) presents the annual death rates among different household occupation groups. The mortality is found to be relatively high (10.0/1000 persons) in the households having agriculture as household occupation and lowest in households under occupation group "administrative and executive work (4.1/1000 persons).

**3.10 Infant mortality rate by per capita monthly household expenditure classes.**—The annual infant mortality rates per 1000 live-births among different per capita monthly household expenditure classes are presented in Table (3.9). It is low in lower per capita expenditure classes, increases with increasing per capita expenditure attaining maximum (85.3 per 1000 live-births) in the expenditure class Rs. 26—30 and then declines uniformly in the subsequent classes. The agreement of infant mortality rates over different per capital monthly household expenditure classes in the sixteenth and seventeenth round is found to be generally good.

**3.11 Infant mortality rates by household occupation groups.**—Table (3.10) presents the annual infant mortality rates per 1000 live-births among different household occupation groups. The households of 'craftsmen and production process worker's were found to have highest infant mortality rate (83.6 per 1000 live-births) with agricultural households coming as a close second (82.3 per 1000 live-births). The infant mortality is found to be lowest in households under occupation group "administrative and executive works".

3.11 *Distribution of live-births by place of occurrence and attendance type.*—Table (3.11) gives the percentage distribution of births by place of occurrence of births and type of attendance at the all-India urban level. A high proportion of births (86.31 per cent) were reported to have occurred within the town or city in which the households are normally resident; out of the above births, 62.17 per cent occurred in the premises occupied by the household, 21.33 per cent in hospitals, maternity homes, etc. and 1.98 per cent in child's mother's father's premises. Among the births (born) outside the town or city (13.69 per cent), 7.02 per cent were born in child's mother's father's premises and 3.08 per cent in hospitals, maternity homes, etc. Thus, for all births, 64.50 per cent occurred in own premises, 9.00 per cent in child's mother's father's premises and 24.41 per cent in hospitals, maternity homes, etc. Of the total births, 23.18 per cent were attended by physician, 44.69 per cent by Dhai and 12.46 per cent by midwife or qualified nurse.

3.12. *Distribution of deaths by place of occurrence and type of attendance.*—Table (3.12) gives the percentage distribution of deaths by place of occurrence and type of attendance. Of all deaths, 91.35 per cent were reported to have occurred in the town or city where the deceased were normally resident; 82.34 per cent of total deaths occurred in the premises of the deceased, and 10.79 per cent in the hospitals, maternity homes, etc. Physicians were reported to have attended in 45.77 per cent of the cases.

APPENDIX Two  
SAMPLE DESIGN

1. The sampling design for the enquiry on current population, births and deaths was generally uni-stage stratified with urban blocks as the sampling units.

2. The urban areas of each state and Union Territory excepting Maharashtra was divided into two sectors—sector 1 consisting of towns and cities with 1951 population 50,000 or more (class I and class II towns) and sector 2 consisting of the rest of the urban areas. Maharashtra had three sectors : sec or 'O' consisting of Bombay city, sector 1 of state capital and all towns and cities with 1951 census population 50,000 or more excluding Bombay city and sector '2' the remaining urban areas. Sector 1 towns and cities within a state formed a separate stratum and the urban areas comprising sector 2 towns and cities within each of 48 regions covering the whole of India formed separate strata. In Maharashtra, Bombay city (sector 'O') formed a separate stratum.

3. The allocation of 2272 urban blocks to the two sectors was made with twice the weightage to sector 1 and within each sector the allocation to each state was made in proportion to its population in that sector. The final allocations to the states were rounded off to multiples of 16. In sector 2, the allocation to a state was further distributed to the regions in it, proportional to the number of urban blocks in that sector keeping the final allocations multiples of 2.

4. In each stratum of sector 1, the urban blocks were selected systematically with a random start for each of the two interpenetrating samples from the list of urban blocks of 1951 census except 81 towns in which the list of urban blocks prepared by NSS in the Urban Frame Survey (1960) was used. In case of sector 2 stratum, the towns within each region were arranged according to their means of livelihood pattern before selection and then the blocks were selected using the list of 1951 census blocks in a circular systematic fashion.

5. To reduce the work-load in case of a very large urban block, the investigator was allowed to divide the block into a number of compact identifiable sub-blocks of roughly equal population content and select one of them at random with equal probability.

6. The survey period of NSS 16th round was divided into two sub-rounds of equal duration. : the blocks with odd order of selection were surveyed in the first sub-round and the blocks with even order in the second sub-round.

7. The estimates of rates and ratios given in this report were obtained from the simple unbiased estimates of the numerator and the denominator by applying the proper multiplying factors.

8. *Estimates of aggregates and ratios.*—Let  $Y_{hij}$  be the aggregates of Y characteristic in the j-th block of the i-th stratum of the h-th state. Let  $N_{hi}$  be the total number of urban blocks and  $n_{hi}$  the number of sample blocks of the h-i-th stratum. The simple unbiased estimates of the aggregate of Y for the h-th state and all-India urban from one sub-sample are given by :

$$(i) \text{ h-th state} : Y_{hxx} = \sum_i \frac{N_{hi}}{n_{hi}} \sum_{j=i}^{n_{hi}} Y_{hij}$$

$$(ii) \text{ all-India} : Y_{xxx} = \sum_h Y_{hxx}$$

The ratios of two simple unbiased estimates of aggregates Y and X are given at the h-th state and all-India levels from one sub-sample are given by :

$$(i) \text{ h-th state} : r_{hxx} = Y_{hxx} / X_{hxx}$$

$$(ii) \text{ all-India} : r_{xxx} = Y_{xxx} / X_{xxx}$$

where  $X_{hij}$ ,  $X_{hxx}$  are similarly defined as for the Y's.
