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SECTION ONE

Introduction

1.0 The National Sample Survey Organisation (NSSO) decided to devote the thirtieth round (July 1975 - June 1976) of the National Sample Survey (NSS) exclusively to an enquiry of livestock numbers, products and livestock enterprises with the objective of filling up the gaps in the area of animal husbandry statistics.

Geographical coverage

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1.1 The survey was spread over the whole of the Indian Union excepting Ladakh district of Jammu & Kashmir; rural areas of Pal and Samri tehsils of district Sarguja and Bijapur, Dantewara, Konta and Narayanpur tehsils of district Bastar of Madhya Pradesh; Rajura, Sironcha and Gadch - Chiroli tehsils of district Chandrapur and Melghat tehsil of district Amravati of Maharashtra; rural areas in Nagaland; disturbed villages of Tripura; rural areas of the Union Territory of Chandigarh; the Union Territories of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Mizoram, Laccadive, Minicoy and Amindivi Islands and Dadra & Nagar Haveli.

Sample size and field work

1.2 The survey was carried out in 18856 sample villages and 20440 urban sample blocks. Of these, 8512 sample villages and 9744 blocks formed the Central Sample and were surveyed by the NSSO staff belonging to its Field Operation Division. Under the NSS matching scheme the remaining villages and blocks constituting the State Sample were surveyed by the field staff of the respective State (or Union territory) Statistical Agencies. 24 households from each of the sample villages and 24 households, on an average, from a urban sample block were selected for the survey 1/.

Survey coverage

1.3 The following six schedules of investigation were canvassed in the surveys (i) Household Schedule 19.1 - cattle, buffalo, yak, mithun and poultry, (ii) Household Schedule 19.2 - horse, donkey, mule, camel and elephant, (iii) Household Schedule 19.3 - sheep, goat and pig, (iv) Household Schedule 19.4 - consumption of livestock products, (v) Household Schedule 20 - livestock enterprises and (vi) Schedule 20.1 - Non-household livestock enterprises. Besides these, some ancillary village level data having some bearing on the development of animal husbandry activities were also collected through a village schedule 3.1. Another village schedule 3.2 was canvassed for collecting information on migratory flocks of bovines, pack animals and ovines.

1.4 Some estimates of the number and the related characteristics of pack animals, namely, horse, donkey, mule, camel and elephant based on the data collected through Schedule 19.2 pertaining to the Central Sample are presented and discussed in this Report.

Tabulation programme for schedule 19.2

1.5 As very few households reported to have possessed pack animals, a few tables on only some basic information on these animals are included in the approved tabulation programme for this schedule. The items provided in the tabulation programme were those which would throw up estimates on the number and value of animals possessed, the distribution of households by size of animal holding and the distribution of animals and their value by age-group. The tabulation programme also included tables giving the estimates of production of milk and hair by camels and donkeys and other products from the pack animals. But on examination of the results, it was observed that no meaningful estimate on production of milk and hair by camel and donkey and on other products of the pack animals could be presented as in majority of the states, the households possessing these animals did not report information on these items and as such the resulting estimates became zero in those states. Hence, the estimates of the products generated by pack animals have not been presented in the report.

Presentation of tables

1.6 The tables are presented at the state and all - India levels in Appendix-II. However, table (1) which gives the number and value of animals possessed by species cross classified by sex provides also the regional estimates for each state. *Mostly percentage and ratio estimates are presented in these tables. The aggregate estimates if required can be derived by using the suitable base figures provided in the report.*

Participation of states

1.7 All the States and Union Territories except Gujarat, Haryana, Maharashtra, Orissa, Delhi and Goa, Daman and Diu participated in the survey on full matching basis. While Gujarat and Delhi had double matching sample in both rural and urban sectors, Maharashtra and Orissa participated on double matching basis in rural sector only and on full matching basis in urban sector. Haryana had a sample size of two and a half times the Central Sample in rural areas and double matching sample in urban areas while for Goa, Daman and Diu, the sample size was four times the size of the Central Sample in rural areas and three times in urban areas.

1.8 List of NSS regions and facsimile of the schedule of enquiry are given in Appendix - III and IV respectively.

SECTION TWO

Some findings of the survey

2.0 Some important survey findings separately for rural and urban sectors at state and all-India levels are given in the following paragraphs.

2.1 Percentage of households reporting pack animals and average number possessed by reporting households : Horse, donkey, mule, camel and elephant exist only in a limited number in the Indian states. These beasts of burden with the exception of elephant are found more in the northern parts of the country although some of them, namely, horse and donkey are seen also in scattered areas in other parts. An idea regarding the spread of these animals over the different parts of the country together with the varying strength in their number can be obtained from the estimates given in Table (A) which provides of the percentage of households reporting possession of pack animals and average number possessed by reporting households.

2.2 The estimates presented in Table (A) reveal that in the rural India, percentage of households reporting possession of animals of these species is highest for camel and it is 0.73. In this aspect, camel is followed by horse (0.55 percent) donkey (0.34 percent), mule (0.03 percent) and elephant (0.002 percent). Average number of animals possessed by reporting households is highest for donkey, it being 2.51. Mules comes next with 1.95 animals per reporting household. Camel which is reported by the maximum number of households comes third with 1.34 animals per reporting household. Average number of animals per reporting household is very close for horse and elephant, these being 1.22 and 1.19 respectively.

2.3 It is further seen that the percentages of households possessing camel and horse show considerable variation over the states and the range of this variation is, however, not appreciable in the case of donkey, mule and elephant. Whereas camel is reported by 9.72 percent households in Rajasthan, 6.53 percent in Haryana, 3.23 percent in Punjab and negligible percent in the neighbouring states, it is not reported in the other parts of rural India. As regards horse, this percentage is as high as 5.46 in Jammu & Kashmir and 2.42 in Himachal Pradesh and negligible in South and East Indian states. The variation in the average number of animals possessed by reporting households is not observed to be large over the states in respect of horse, mule, camel and elephant. But for donkey, appreciable variation of this number over the states is noticed. When it is more than 4 in Delhi, nearly 4 in Maharashtra and nearly 3 in Gujarat, Haryana and Karnataka, it is less than 2 in Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Jammu & Kashmir and West Bengal.

2.4 Compared to the rural sector the percentage of households reporting pack animals in urban sector is much less and as regards elephant, not a single household in the urban sector reported possession of this animal. At the all-India level, percentage of households reporting possession of donkey is 0.19 and horse is 0.18 while the corresponding figures for the rural sector are 0.34 and 0.55 respectively. Camel is found to be more a rural animal as only 0.07 percent of the urban households report possession of this animal as against 0.73 percent reported in the rural sector. Mule is reported only by 0.01 percent of the urban households as against 0.03 percent in the rural sector. Average number of animals possessed by reporting households for the different species is almost the same in both the sectors.

2.5 The observed variation in the percentages of households reporting possession of pack animals in different states is less in the urban sector. This percentage for horse is highest in Jammu & Kashmir and it is the only state which reports around 1 percent of such households. Next comes Uttar Pradesh with 0.44 percent households reporting possession of horse. As regards donkey only three states namely Punjab, Haryana and Uttar Pradesh have more than 0.50 percent households possessing this animal and the respective percentages are 0.63, 0.53 and 0.52. Percentage of households possessing mule is highest for Himachal Pradesh (0.15 percent) closely followed by Punjab (0.14 percent). Households possessing camel form sizable proportion only in Rajasthan and Punjab, percentage of such households being 0.94 and 0.74 respectively. Though average number of horse or camel per reporting household does not show any marked variation over the states, substantial variation is noticed in respect of donkey and mule. Average number of donkeys possessed by reporting households is more than 4 in Himachal Pradesh, Maharashtra and Delhi and is between 3 and 4 in Gujarat, Karnataka and Madhya Pradesh. This number, however, is less than 2 in Andhra Pradesh, Bihar and Jammu & Kashmir. In the case of mule, average number per reporting household is around 3 in Jammu & Kashmir and Madhya Pradesh whereas it is less than 2 in Bihar, Haryana and Punjab and Uttar Pradesh.

2.6 Distribution of households possessing pack animals over size of animal holding

It has already been stated in paragraph 2.2 that out of 10,000 households, on an average, camel was reported in 73 households, horse in 55 households, donkey in 34 households and mule in 3 households in rural India. In the urban areas still fewer households reported possession of these animals. In case of elephant only 2 out of one lakh households in rural and no household in urban areas reported to have possessed the animal. Of the households reporting possession of pack animals, the percentages of those possessing one, two and three or more animals for each species are given in Table (B) separately for rural and urban India. It is observed that in respect of horse and camel in both rural and urban sectors and elephant in the rural sector, more than 80 percent of the reporting households possess only one animal.

2.7 Households possessing more than one animal constitute only 19.36 percent of the reporting households for horse 18.62 percent for camel and 19.25 percent for elephant in the rural sector and 18.11 percent for horse and 5.65 percent for camel in the urban sector. The proportion of households possessing more than 2 animals of any species varies from species to species and is 2.30 percent for horse, 6.00 percent for camel and nil percent for elephant in the rural sector and 5.20 percent for horse and 1.72 percent for camel in the urban sector. But possession of more than one animal is not a rare phenomenon for donkey and mule, particularly for donkey. Only 34.64 percent of the rural and 28.01 percent of the urban households possessing donkey report possession of only one animal. On the other hand, households possessing 3 or more donkeys form a sizable proportion of the total reporting households both in rural and urban sectors, those forming 37.64 percent and 39.87 percent respectively. Households possessing only one mule form only 45.43 percent of the total reporting households in the rural sector and 49.30 percent households in the urban sector. Households possessing 3 or more mule constitute 22.84 percent of the total reporting households in the rural sector and 16.73 percent households in the urban sector.

2.8 Average value of pack animals by species : Average value of pack animals in the reporting states and for all India ^{are} presented in Table (C) below :

2.9 A horse, on an average, ^{is valued} costs Rs.557 in rural India and Rs.607 in urban India. Donkey too is ^{valued} priced more in the urban sector, the average value being Rs.114 in the rural sector and Rs.131 in the urban sector. Camel is no exception in this regard, its average value being Rs.1027 in the rural sector and Rs.1170 in the urban sector. It is interesting to note that the average, ^{value} price of a mule in the rural sector is higher than that of a camel by Rs.258 whereas it is ^{valued} ~~priced~~ Rs.393 ³⁹³ less than a camel in the urban sector.

2.10 The value of a horse is comparatively high in the North Indian States in both the sectors. For instance, the average ^{value} price of a horse in rural ^{Karnataka} Kerala is only Rs.233 as against Rs.1069 in rural Punjab. Similar variation in ^{value} price is observed for donkey too. Incidentally, it may be relevant to mention here that these animals are found in greater number in the north Indian states where they are ^{valued} priced comparatively high.

2.10 Age distribution of pack animals and their average value : Distribution of pack animals and their average value by age-group is given separately for each species in Table (D) below :

2.11 Percentage of animals of age below 3 years is highest for donkey both in the rural and urban sectors. Likewise the percentage of animals of age 10 years and above is highest for camel in both the sectors. The average price of an animal, generally speaking, is more for the animals in the two middle age groups than the animals in the lowest and the highest age-groups. Mule, however, is an exception in the sense that the average price of a mule increases with increase in age in the rural sector. However, in the urban sector the average value of a mule in younger age-group (3 to 5 years) is the highest.

2.12 Comparison of the NSS estimates with 1972 livestock census figure :

The number of animals (in thousands) as per 1972 Indian Livestock Census (ILC) and as estimated by NSS 30th Round Survey for the rural and urban sectors taken together along with the percentage difference $\frac{1}{2}$ between the two sets of estimates are given for each state and all-India in table (E) below. Only those states which reported 5000 or more of any of these pack animals as per 1972, ILC are included in the table, although the All-India figures are based on the total geographical coverage of the survey.

2.13 The NSS estimates of the number of animals are generally less than the ILC figures for the large majority of the states and for all-India. The difference at all-India level is in the order of 34 percent for horse, 14 percent for donkey, 20 percent for mule and 24 percent for camel. The NSS estimates for number of animals is more than or equal to the corresponding ILC figures for horse in Himachal Pradesh only, for donkey in Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Himachal Pradesh, Maharashtra, Rajasthan and Delhi, for mule in Himachal Pradesh and Punjab and for camel only in Uttar Pradesh.

APPENDIX-I

SAMPLE DESIGN AND ESTIMATION PROCEDURE

Sample Design

1. Sample Design : The sample design is a stratified two stage design. The first stage units are 1971 census villages in rural areas and urban blocks in urban areas and the second stage units are households. ^{for schedule 1971} The design has been made self-weighting at the region level in rural sector and at the state level in urban sector.

2. Sample size (Central Sample): The Central Sample consists of 8512 villages and 9744 blocks.

3. Stratification : The whole of India has been divided into a number of basic strata so that the basic strata do not cut across district boundaries. Districts with more than 1.5 million 1971 census rural population have been divided into 2 or more basic strata by grouping contiguous tehsils (or sub-divisions in Bihar, Orissa and West Bengal) homogeneous, as far as possible, with respect to density of rural population and crop-pattern, so that the population of each basic stratum is less than 1.5 million. Each district with less than 1.5 million 1971 rural population forms one basic stratum by itself except in Gujarat where some districts with less than 1.5 million rural population have been divided into 2 basic strata on consideration of concentration of the tribal population and dry areas of the state. Basic strata so formed have been treated as basic strata both for rural and urban sectors. In the urban sector, however, some of the basic strata with very low urban population content have been merged together to form urban strata with sizable urban population. In all such cases, however, the separate entity of the district has been retained in general except in case of districts with very low urban population where such districts have been merged with neighbouring districts in the same region for urban strata formation.

Out of 374 districts in India, 366 districts are within the survey coverage of the NSS. Total number of basic strata formed in these 366 districts is 520 in rural areas and 511 in urban areas. Total number of urban strata is 386.

4. Allocation : The all-India sample of villages and blocks have been allocated to the different states and union territories considering their investigator strengths and rural/urban population.

Within each state and union territory, the allocated number of villages and blocks have been distributed over the constituent basic strata and urban strata in proportion to their rural and urban population respectively. These allocation have been made multiples of 4.

5. Selection of villages : The 1971 census list of villages has been used as the sampling frame for selection of villages. Sample villages within each basic stratum have been selected with probability proportional to 1971 census population and with replacement, in the form of two independent sub-samples.

6. Selection of blocks : Within each urban stratum the allocated number of blocks have been selected with probability proportional to size (pps) where size is a measure of population, and with replacement, in the form of two independent sub-samples.

Urban Frame Survey (UFS) blocks in cities and towns where UFS has been done and 1971 census blocks where UFS has not been done have been used for selection of blocks.

7. Selection of revenue village : In rural areas the first stage sampling unit as also the unit of survey is the census village (1971 population census). Generally the survey work is conducted in the sampled census village. But sometimes the sample census village cannot be uniquely identified. In such cases two types of situations may arise - (a) the sample census village contains two or more revenue villages wholly or partly. Then all the revenue villages taken together is taken as the unit of survey, (b) the sample census village is wholly contained within a bigger revenue village which contains, wholly or partly, other census villages also. Then this bigger revenue village is surveyed.

8. Hamlet group/sub-block selection : Villages/blocks with large population content are divided into two or more compact, areal sub-divisions of nearly equal population content. These sub-divisions are called hamlet-groups and sub-blocks in the case of villages and blocks respectively. The survey is conducted in one of the sub-divisions (formed in a village or block) selected at random.

9. Selection of sample households : All the households in a sample village/block are arranged in a frame with households possessing any livestock or poultry on the date of listing coming first followed by the other households. In a sample village, a sample of 24 households is selected circular systematically from this arranged frame whereas in a sample block, a sample of households (24 on the average) is selected linear systematically with a pre-specified interval. All the selected households in a sample village/block are surveyed.

Estimation Procedure

10. The estimation procedure is described below for rural and urban sectors separately.

11. Rural sector : Let Y_r denote the aggregate for region r of any item y on which information is collected. Then its estimate \hat{Y}_r is given by $\hat{Y}_r = M_{ri} y_{ri} \dots \dots \dots (1)$

where y_{ri} is the value for i^{th} sample households of r^{th} region and M_r is the multiplier for r^{th} region given by

$$M_r = \frac{\hat{H}_r}{h_r} \dots \dots \dots (2)$$

where \hat{H}_r is the total number of households in the r^{th} region as estimated unbiasedly from schedule O.1 (listing schedule) and h_r is the number of sample households available for tabulation for schedule 19 series.

12. The estimates of a State aggregates are obtained by adding the estimates of all the constituent regions.

13. Estimates of ratio are obtained by first obtaining the estimates of aggregates of the numerator and denominator of a given ratio and then by division at the final stage.

14. Urban sector: In the urban sector, the aggregate of item y at state level is given by $\hat{Y} = M \sum_i y_i \dots \dots \dots (3)$

where M is the self-weighting multiplier at state level and y_i is the value of y for the i^{th} sample household.

15. Regionwise estimates are obtained by restricting the summation to the sample households of each given region.

16. Estimates of ratios are computed, as in the rural sector, by estimating first the numerator and the denominator and then by division at the final stage.
