INTRODUCTION

In the twenty-eighth round of the National Sample Survey (NSS), particulars on physical & mental disability were collected along with the enquiry on population, births, deaths, migration and morbidity. Information on present age, sex, cause and type of disability and age at disability was elicited from all normal resident members of the household.

The survey extended over the whole of India excepting Ladakh district of Jammu & Kashmir, Mizoram, Arunachal Pradesh, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Laccadive, Minicoy and Amindivi Islands, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, rural areas of Chandigarh and of Nagaland, some rural areas in Tripura and in the districts of Surguja and Bastar of Madhya Pradesh and Chanda and Amravati of Maharashtra.

The survey started in October 1973 and continued upto June 1974.

Broadly, the sample design was a stratified two-stage one with households as the second stage units and self-weighting at the state level for the rural and the urban sectors separately. In all 1.29 and 0.67 lakhs of sample households were surveyed in 9034 villages and 5063 urban blocks respectively in the Central Sample on which the present report is based. The sample design and procedure of estimation are described in Appendix-I.

CONCEPTS AND DEFINITIONS

Household - normally resident members and visitors : Persons who usually lived together and took food from the same kitchen were considered as usual or normally resident members of the household. Other members not usually residing in the household were classified as visitors. If a person lived in a place and took food at some other place, he was considered usual member at the place where he lived. Inmates (including the staff) of a mess, hotel, orphanage etc. were treated as single member households. However, a family living in any one of the establishments was treated as a separate household by itself.

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In Schedule 12, NSS 28th round, disabled persons comprised of physically handicapped and mentally affected persons. If a normal resident member of any household had one or more physical defects like blindness of one or both eyes, deafness, dumbness, speech defect, lameness of one or both legs, loss of fingers, hand, arm, toes, foot, leg etc., paralysis of any kind, cleft palate, club foot, permanent stiffness or deformities of foot, leg, hand, arm etc., and/or was mentally retarded or insane he was considered as a disabled person. Information on cause of disability was collected under the heads as (i) congenital (since birth), (ii) accident, (iii) leprosy, (iv) paralysis including polio and (v) other diseases.

Particulars on physical and mental disability were tabulated for all usual members of households. The estimates presented are based on Central Sample only. The estimates for Jammu & Kashmir are however based on both the Central and State Samples.

The number of disabled persons per 100,000 person for any cause of disability by age, sex and sector was obtained by dividing the number of disabled persons for a particular age, sex and sector for the cause of disability in question by the estimated population of the corresponding age, sex and sector and then multiplied by 100,000.

The estimated population used as the base for calculating the number of disabled persons per 100,000 was derived by adding, to the estimated population as on the date of survey, half the estimated number of deaths during the preceding year and subtracting half the estimated number of live births during the same period.

SUMMARY FINDINGS

The salient feature of the findings on physical and mental disability as obtained from the NSS 28th round relating to all-India are briefly described in the following paragraphs.

Table (1) below shows the number of persons per 100,000 persons suffering from selected disabilities. It is seen from the table that in the rural areas the number of persons suffering from blindness of one eye, blindness of both eyes, lameness of one leg were respectively 121, 143 and 94. In the urban areas the number of persons suffering from similar disabilities were respectively 83, 71 and 72. The number of

persons suffering from mental retardation in the rural areas were 72. In the urban areas the number of persons suffering from mental retardation were 98. Except for blindness for both eyes in rural areas the number of disabled males per 100,000 males were higher than the corresponding number of disabled females per 1,00,000 females in both the rural and urban areas for the disabilities considered in the table.

Table (2) shows the number of disabled persons per 100,000 persons by cause of disability and sex and sector. The table reveals that congenital disability was by far the most important single cause of disability in both rural and urban sectors. The number of persons with congenital disability per 100,000 persons were estimated as 221 and 183 in rural and urban areas respectively. Accident and paralysis including polio were two other causes of which claimed about 100 or more disabled persons per 1,00,000 persons in both the rural and urban sectors. The table also shows that a large number of persons were disabled due to other diseases, the figures being 366 for rural and 280 for urban areas. Number of disabled males were appreciably higher than that of females irrespective of causes of disability and sectors.

Number of persons disabled for all causes of disability per 100,000 persons by age, sex and sector has been presented in table (3). This table shows that the number of disabled persons per 100,000 persons increased with age. This was true for male as well as for female in both the rural and urban sectors.

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APPENDIX - I

SAMPLING DESIGN AND ESTIMATION PROCEDURE

A stratified two stage design was adopted for the survey. The first stage units were villages in the rural sector and blocks in the urban sector and the second stage units were households from which the information was collected.

The whole of India was divided into 524 basic strata so that the basic strata did not cut across district boundaries. A district with less than 1.5 million 1971 census rural population formed 2 or more basic strata (by grouping contiguous tehsils) depending on their rural population. In Gujarat, however districts with population less than 1.5 million were divided into two strata in consideration of dry areas and concentration of tribal population at the request of SSB of that state.

Within each State and Union Territory the allotted number of villages and blocks were distributed over the constituent basic strata in proportion to their rural and urban population respectively.

The 1971 census list of villages was used as the sampling frame for selection of villages. Sample villages within each basic stratum were selected with probability proportional to population and with replacement in the form of two independent sub-samples.

All cities and towns within each basic stratum were grouped into a number of urban sub-strata. All towns with 1971 census population less than 20,000 formed sub-stratum 1, towns with 1971 population 20,000 to 49,999 formed sub-stratum 2 and those with 1971 population 50,000 to 99,999 formed sub-stratum 3. Each city with 1971 population 1,00,000 or more constituted a separate urban sub-stratum. Within each urban stratum, the allocated number of blocks was further allocated to the constituent sub-strata circular systematically with probability proportional to urban populations of the respective sub-strata. Within each urban

sub-stratum, the allocated number of blocks were selected with probability proportional to size and with replacement.

Villages and blocks with large population content were divided into two or more compact areal sub-divisions of nearly equal population content. One of these sub-divisions (called hamlet in a village and sub-block in a block) was selected at random and the survey was confined to the selected sub-division only.

All households in a sample village/hamlet group were arranged into 6 classes on the basis of their means of livelihood viz., (i) landless labour, (ii) cultivator and (iii) others and whether (i) visited health centre or (ii) not. All households in a sample block/sub-block were also arranged into 6 classes by occupation divisions (0-1 and 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7-8-9 and X). From the arranged frame in a village/block, a sample of households was selected linear systematically using the intervals and random strats specified. Sampling intervals were so fixed as to make the design selfweighting at the state level separately for rural and urban sectors.

Unbiased method of estimation was adopted for estimating aggregate values of the characteristics, say, X, Y, Z, etc. under enquiry. Estimates of ratios were derived by dividing unbiased estimates of the numerators by the unbiased estimates of the denominators.
