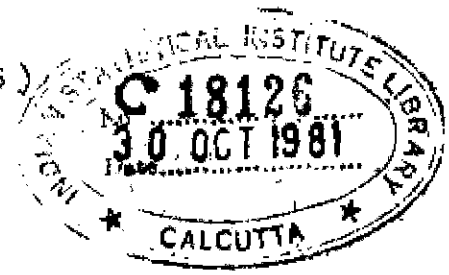

Section One

I n t r o d u c t i o n

1.0 Objective : In order to fill up the gap in the field of animal husbandry statistics, a comprehensive survey on the livestock number, products and enterprises was carried out in the thirtieth round of NSS (July 1975 - June 1976). Since the entire round was devoted mainly to the livestock survey, it was felt necessary to collect simultaneously, some ancillary background information, at the village level, on (i) the livestock development projects, (ii) the facilities available for livestock raising, (iii) the availability of marketing agencies for purchase and sale of livestock and its products and (iv) other related aspects. Besides collecting the information of the general nature as mentioned above, the 1972 census figures of the number of livestock and poultry classified by age, sex and use, possessed by the households of the sample village were also compiled from the agricultural census record and recorded in the schedule of enquiry (village schedule 3.1). The facsimile of the schedule is given in Appendix V. In this survey, the information pertaining to the entire village and not to the hamlet group only<sup>1/</sup> were recorded. The present report provides estimates of the proportion of villages reporting availability of various facilities for livestock development at the regional, state and all-India levels.

1.1 Sample size and field work : The survey was carried out in 18356 villages of which the investigation in 8512 villages (constituting the Central Sample) was conducted by the Field Operation Division of the NSSO. The investigation in the remaining villages (which constituted the State Sample) was done by the field staff of the different State Statistical Agencies on a matching basis.

1.2 Participation of states : All the state governments except Gujarat, Haryana, Maharashtra, Orissa, Delhi and Goa, Daman & Diu participated in the work of the NSS-30th round on full matching basis. While Gujarat, Maharashtra, Orissa and Delhi participated in the 30th round programme on double matching basis, Haryana had two and a half times the sample size than that of the Central Sample. In Goa, Daman & Diu, the sample size was four times than those of the Central Sample.

livestock enterprise by distance of the village from the location of facility. Table 8 to 10, which were intended to provide estimates of livestock and poultry numbers (as per the 1972 livestock census) classified by age, sex and use at the regional and higher levels, have not been included in the report as in a large number of cases village level figures could not be procured from the census records and thereby large number of cells corresponding to those items remained blank in the schedule of enquiry. Also in some cases census figures at the tehsil/block level were available to the investigating staff who recorded the same in the schedule of enquiry. Obviously, such figures had to be ignored at the tabulation stage. It is relevant to mention here that in the present report estimates of proportion of villages reporting availability of various facilities for livestock development have been given, the proportions being worked out from the estimates of total number of villages and of villages reporting a facility derived from the survey data. The tables have, as scheduled, been prepared by regions,<sup>3/</sup> states/union territories and all-India for all sub-rounds taken together for the rural areas based on the central sample data.

Section Two

SUMMARY FINDINGS

2.0 Some important findings of the survey, as revealed from the tables presented in Appendix II of this report, are discussed in the subsequent paragraphs.

2.1 Cultivation of fodder<sup>4/</sup> : About one-third of the villages in India reported cultivation of fodder (Table 1, Appendix II). Among the states, Haryana reported the highest percentage of such villages (88.25) followed by Punjab (85.53), Rajasthan (78.48), Delhi (70.68), Gujarat (59.81) and Uttar Pradesh (59.27). While Meghalaya and Pondicherry reported no area under fodder cultivation in the villages, comparatively small percentage of villages were reported to be under fodder cultivation in the states Tripura (1.08), West Bengal (3.61), Kerala (4.09), Orissa (4.16), Madhya Pradesh (5.95), Goa, Daman & Diu (8.98), Assam (11.47) and Tamil Nadu (15.31).

2.2 Noticable regional variations in the percentage of villages reporting fodder cultivation were observed between the regions of the states Jammu & Kashmir, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra and Uttar Pradesh.

2.3 The distribution of villages reporting fodder cultivation over size brackets of area under fodder reveals (Table 2, Appendix II) that only about 10 p.c. of the 34 p.c. villages in India reporting fodder cultivation had 51 acres or more of area under fodder. Under the same size brackets (51 acres or more), Haryana again reported the highest percentage of villages (72.99) followed by Punjab (57.12), Rajasthan (40.28), and Gujarat (32.91). It is relevant to note in this connection that though Uttar Pradesh had fairly large number of villages reporting fodder cultivation (59.27 p.c.) compared to all-India percentage of 34.06, the percentage of villages having fodder area 51 acres and above was only 7.85 which was less than the corresponding all-India figure of 9.74.

2.4 Pastures<sup>5/</sup> in villages : In 9 out of 23 states/union territories, the percentage of villages having area under pasture is 50 and above (Table 1, Appendix II). They are : Himachal Pradesh (85.68 p.c.), Madhya Pradesh (83.68 p.c.), Rajasthan (80.92 p.c.), Maharashtra (77.15 p.c.), Gujarat (74.45 p.c.), Karnataka (62.21 p.c.), Jammu & Kashmir (61.45 p.c.), Haryana (53.62 p.c.) and Andhra Pradesh (51.51 p.c.). The corresponding all-India figure is 46.03 p.c.

The percentage of villages reporting area under pasture was quite low in Tripura(0.30), West Bengal(5.50), Delhi(16.54), Manipur(16.87), Punjab(18.11) and Kerala(18.42).

2.5 An analysis of the estimates of the percentage of villages reporting area under pasture in the regions within the states reveals considerable variations in these estimates between the regions. However, such variations are more pronounced in the regions of the states Karnataka, Jammu & Kashmir, Kerala and West Bengal.

2.6 Again, the estimate of the percentage distribution of number of villages over size groups of area under pasture (Table 2, Appendix-II) reveals that about 22 percent of the villages in India reporting area under pasture had 51 acres or more of area under pasture. Rajasthan reported maximum number of villages (55.51 p.c.) under the same size bracket followed by Madhya Pradesh(53.20 p.c.), Gujarat(47.30 p.c.), Maharashtra(44.50 p.c.), Jammu & Kashmir(32.60 p.c.), Andhra Pradesh (30.03 p.c.), Himachal Pradesh(29.76 p.c.), Karnataka(26.47 p.c.) and Haryana(14.93 p.c.).

2.7 It is worthwhile to mention here that the number of villages with areas under fodder in almost all the states and all-India were much less than the number of villages with areas under pasture except in Haryana, Punjab, Uttar Pradesh, Delhi and Tripura.

2.8 Common grazing land<sup>6/</sup> in villages : To have some idea about the common grazing land in the villages, it can be seen from Table 1, Appendix-II again, that about 32 p.c. of the villages in India were having areas under common grazing land. The states which had such areas in more than 50 p.c. of their villages are Rajasthan(75.20 p.c.), Gujarat(64.62 p.c.), Madhya Pradesh(61.92 p.c.), Himachal Pradesh(60.76 p.c.) and Maharashtra (54.12 p.c.). On the other hand, the percentage of villages reporting common grazing land in Tamil Nadu(17.32), Assam(14.51), Bihar(13.90), Manipur(8.44), Meghalaya(7.28), West Bengal(4.08), Kerala(2.56), Goa, Daman & Diu(0.41) and Tripura(0.05) were much below the corresponding all-India estimate(31.94).

2.9 An analysis about the condition (good, fair, bad) of the common grazing land can be made from Table 4, Appendix-II. Of the five states (with areas under common grazing land in more than 50% of their villages) Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat and Himachal Pradesh were having common grazing land in good condition in about only 10 p.c. of the reporting villages. At the all-India level also 10 p.c. of the villages reporting common grazing land had maintained the grazing land in good condition. The corresponding figures in Maharashtra and Rajasthan were 7.19 p.c. and 4.54 p.c. respectively. It may be noted that in Rajasthan which had common grazing land in 75.20 p.c. of its villages, only 4.54 p.c. of such villages maintained common grazing land in good condition. However, in the villages of these five states as well as those at the all-India level, fairly good percentage (about 60 p.c.) of the villages had common grazing land either in good or in fair condition. This situation is also revealed from the estimates of the average area under various categories of common grazing land (good, fair and poor).

On the other hand, in the states where the percentage of villages reporting common grazing land was low such as, Tamil Nadu (17.32), Assam (14.51), Goa, Daman & Diu (8.98), Manipur (8.44) and Meghalaya (7.28), the percentage of the common grazing lands were reported to be in good condition in those states were 20.41, 36.29, 100.00, 14.74 and 49.32 respectively.

2.10 Facilities of different livestock projects in the villages: At the all-India level the percentage of villages with facilities of Co-operative Societies for collection of fluid milk, etc. was about 21 p.c. (Table 5, Appendix-II). The corresponding percentage figures in the states were also not high except for Andhra Pradesh (30 p.c.), Karnataka (45 p.c.), Madhya Pradesh (51 p.c.), Manipur (98 p.c.) and Uttar Pradesh (42 p.c.). Almost all other states exhibited lower percentage figures than the corresponding all-India estimate.

2.11 In respect of other livestock development projects like 'intensive cattle development project', 'key village block' etc., more than 90 p.c. of the villages in Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh and Manipur reported to have possessed the facilities of each of these projects. The corresponding estimates for Assam, Meghalaya, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal were in the range of 77 p.c. to 89 p.c., while about 50 p.c. of

2.12 Other facilities for development of livestock : Another important information in regard to the extent of facilities for promotion of live-stock enterprise (to total number of villages) like 'A.I. Centre', 'Stockman Centre' etc. and 'all-weather road' in the regions, states and all-India can be ascertained from the estimates presented in Table 6, Appendix-II. These facilities were available either within the village or at such a reasonable distance from it as those facilities could be availed of by the villagers.

It is evident from the table that all the states including all-India were having these facilities in about 90 p.c. of the villages except in Meghalaya <sup>where</sup> the corresponding estimates for 'A.I. Centre' and 'Stockman Centre' were about 30 p.c. and for other facilities they were about 75 p.c.

2.13 The position can be further analysed in detail by the distance of the village from the location of such facilities (Table 7, Appendix-II).

To have a comprehensive idea about the availability of those facilities in the real sense of the term, the distance groups presented in Table 7, Appendix-II, have been further summarised into two groups (in place of six presented in the table) viz. 'upto 10 kilometres' and 'above 10 kilometres' and the respective estimates for all the facilities available within 10 kilometres from the reporting villages for all the states and all-India are presented below. :

In rural India, more or less 60 p.c. ~~stage~~ of the villages had facilities for different projects like 'A.I. Centre' etc. within 10 Km. from the village. The different marketing agencies for purchase and sale of livestock and its products, on the other hand, were available (within 10 Km.) to about 41 p.c. ~~stage~~ to 57 p.c. ~~stage~~ of the reporting villages and the 'all weather road' to about 83 percentage of the villages in India.

One significant feature may, in this connection, be mentioned that in all the states including all-India (excepting, of course, Manipur and Meghalaya) at least 70 p.c. ~~stage~~ the reporting villages were situated within 10 kilometres from the nearest 'all weather road'.

SAMPLE DESIGN AND ESTIMATION PROCEDURE

Sample Design

1. General : Schedule 3.1, General Information of the village, was canvassed in the rural sector only. The sample design for this schedule is a stratified uni-stage design. the sampling units of which are 1971 census villages.
2. Sample size (Central Sample) : The Central Sample consists of 8512 villages. For state-wise distribution of sample villages, See Table (O), Appendix-II.
3. Sub-round : The survey period of 12 months (from July 1975 to June 1976) has been divided into 4 sub-rounds of 3 months each. Number of sample villages are equal for each of the four sub-rounds in each of the strata.
4. Stratification : The whole of India has been divided into a number of basic strata so that the basic strata do not cut across district boundaries. Districts with more than 1.5 million 1971 census rural population have been divided into 2 or more basic strata by grouping contiguous tehsils (or sub-divisions in Bihar, Orissa and West Bengal), homogeneous, as far as possible, with respect to density of rural population and crop-pattern, so that the population of each basic stratum is less than 1.5 million. Each district with less than 1.5 million 1971 census rural population forms one basic stratum by itself except in Gujarat where some districts with less than 1.5 million rural population have been divided into 2 basic strata on consideration of concentration of the tribal population and dry areas of the state. Basic strata so formed have been treated as basic strata for the rural sector. However, the separate entity of the district has been retained in general.

Out of 374 districts in India, 366 districts are within the survey coverage of the NSS. Total number of basic strata formed in these 366 districts is 520 in rural areas.

5. Allocation : The all-India sample of villages have been allocated to the different states and union territories considering their investi-

Within each state and union territory, the allocated number of villages have been distributed over the constituent basic strata in proportion to their rural population. These allocations have been made multiples of 4.

6. Selection of villages : The 1971 census list of villages has been used as the sampling frame for selection of villages. ~~Sample villages~~. Sample villages within each basic stratum have been selected with probability proportional to 1971 census population and with replacement, in the form of two independent sub-samples.

7. Selection of revenue village : In rural areas the first stage sampling unit and also the unit of survey is the census village (1971 population census). Generally the survey work is conducted in the sampled census village. But sometimes the sample census village cannot be uniquely identified. In such cases two types of situations may arise - (a) the sample census village contains two or more revenue villages wholly or partly. Then all the revenue villages taken together is taken as the unit of survey, (b) the sample census village is wholly contained within a bigger revenue village which contains wholly, or partly, other census villages also. Then this bigger revenue village is surveyed.

Estimation Procedure

8. The estimation procedure adopted for schedule 3,1 is described below.

9. In the following,  $Y$  stands for the estimate of the state total for the characteristic  $y$  in the schedule (3.1) based on the whole sample and for the whole round.

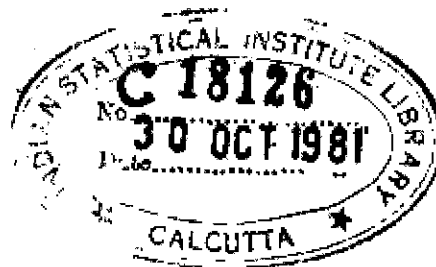
- where :  $K$  = number of strata in the state
- $s$  = subscript for  $s$ -th stratum of a state
- $P$  = total rural population (1971 census - used for selection)
- $m$  = number of surveyed villages including uninhabited and zero cases.
- $p$  = village population (used for selection)
- $i$  = subscript for  $i$ -th sample village
- $f$  = adjustment factor for survey of revenue village
- $y$  = value of characteristics



The value of  $f$  will be 1 in all cases where (i) the sample census village has been surveyed or (ii) all the revenue villages contained wholly or partly in the sample census village have been surveyed. But  $f = \frac{1}{C}$  when the surveyed revenue village contains  $C$  census villages, wholly or partly, including the sample census village. This applies also to cases in which the data of livestock census copied in Sch. 3.1 from records relate to more than one census village including the sample village. For such data (and for such data alone)  $f = \frac{1}{C}$  if the entries relate to  $C$  census villages.

10. It may be mentioned that the estimates of total number of villages and of villages reporting a facility were derived and the percentage of villages reporting the facility to all villages was obtained.

APPENDIX - IV

National Sample Survey, Thirtieth Round : July 1975 - June 1976  
Brief description of the various livestock development projects.

1. Intensive Cattle Development Project (ICDA) : An Intensive Cattle Development Project (ICDA) is a comprehensive development programme which envisages all aspects of Cattle Development, namely, controlled breeding, adequate feeding, effective disease control, feed and fodder development supported by Dairy-Extension and Marketing structure. Each project covers one lakh breedable population of cows/she-buffaloes and is linked with a milk supply scheme to ensure marketing of milk at a remunerative price to the farmer. The programme of a project is implemented through a network of 108 Stockmen Centres each Stockmen Centre covering about 1000 breedable cows/she-buffaloes. An ICDA need not necessarily be located within the boundaries of revenue district but it may cover for its operation a compact area of two or three contiguous districts.
2. Key Village Block : The Key Village Block covers a breedable population of 10,000 cows/she-buffaloes. The activities under the block are channelised through 10 Stockmen Centres.
3. Subsidiary occupation on activities of SFDA/IFAL agency : In the fourth five year-plan, a number of schemes were initiated to assist the small and marginal farmers and agricultural labourers. The programmes for Small Farmers Development Agency (i.e. SFDA) and the Marginal Farmers and Agricultural Labourers Agency (i.e. IFAL) were intended mainly to assist the small and marginal farmers and agricultural labourers, by providing them agricultural inputs, services and credit, to make the maximum utilisation of the productive potential of their small holdings and to help augmenting their income through supplementary occupations like horticulture, animal husbandry, poultry farming and other animal production.
4. Operation Flood Project : The Operation Flood Project, besides expanding the processing facilities at the existing four public sector dairy plants located at Delhi, Bombay, Calcutta and Madras, also makes provision for technical inputs and marketing facilities in the xx/0 states and the Union territory of Delhi covered in the hinterland of these dairy plants.
5. Stockmen Centre : Stockmen centre is the place where breeding facilities by artificial Insemination are available in the hinterland of about 3 to 4 villages. At the Veterinary Hospital/Dispensary, facilities of treatment against disease of animals will be mainly available. The Stockmen at the Stockmen Centre, besides providing artificial Insemination facilities, will also be doing extension work such as arranging supply of concentrate feeds and providing health protection to the animals through vaccinations.
