SECTION ONE

INTRODUCTION

1.1 A survey on small scale enterprises in trade, hotels, restaurants, transport, storage & warehousing and service sector was carried out by the National Sample Survey Organisation in the thirty fourth round of its survey from 1st July 1979 to 30th June 1980. This was a follow-up survey of the first Economic Census which was conducted by the Central Statistical Organisation during the last quarter of 1977. In the Economic Census some broad information about non-agricultural enterprises of the country was collected. As a follow-up of the Economic Census detailed sample surveys of small scale enterprises in (i) manufacture & (ii) trade, hotel & restaurant, transport, storage & warehousing and service sector were conducted by the NSSO respectively in the 33rd and 34th round of the NSS.

1.2 The survey in the 34th round of the NSS covered the entire geographical area of the Indian Union except Sikkim, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Lakshadweep, Dadra Nagar Haveli and the rural area of Nagaland. Two tehsils of district Surguja and four tehsils of district Bastar of Madhya Pradesh, three tehsils of district Chandrapur and one tehsil of district Amravati of Maharashtra and Ladakh district of Jammu & Kashmir were also not covered.

1.3 The Governments of all the States and Union Territories participating in the National Sample Survey Programme participated in the survey by canvassing samples at least of equal size as the central sample in the respective States and Union Territories.

1.4 In the Economic Census, enterprises were classified into two groups namely, (i) un account enterprises (OAE) i.e., enterprises without any hired worker and (ii) establishments i.e., enterprises with at least one hired worker. Establishments having hired workers were further classified into two categories namely, (a) non-directory establishments (NDE) i.e., establishments with total number of workers including household worker, if any, 5 or less and annual

output/turnover/receipt less than Rs.1,00,000 and (b) directory establishments (DE) establishments with 6 or more workers and/or annual output/turnover/receipt Rs.1,00,000 or more. The survey conducted by the NSSO in the thirty fourth round was restricted to non-directory establishments and own account enterprises in trade, hotel & restaurant, transport, storage & warehousing and service sector. The enquiry for the directory establishments was covered by a separate survey conducted by the C.S.O. during October 1979 to September 1980. Government and public sector enterprises were kept out of the purview of the survey.

1.5 The basic design for the survey was a two-stage stratified one with enumeration block (EB) formed during the Economic Census the first stage units (f.s.us) and enterprises as the ultimate units of enumeration. In each sample f.s.u. enterprises which had operated for at least 30 days (or 15 days for seasonal enterprises) during last 365 days and existed on the date of survey formed the frame/selection of enterprises. A sample of own account enterprises and non-directory establishments in trade, hotel and restaurant, transport, storage and warehousing and medical and health services, educational services other than recognised educational institutions and other services was selected for detailed enquiry in each sample EB.

1.6 In each sample EB the enquiry schedule 2.52B - Unrecognised educational non-directory establishments was canvassed for a sample of unrecognised educational non-directory establishments belonging to NIC<sup>a</sup> group 920 & 921. All educational institution conducting courses prescribed by central or state Government by other authorised agency and which satisfied one or more of these authorities were treated as recognised institutions. Such institutions

kept out of the coverage of the survey. The residual institutions conducting courses of study were treated as unrecognised institutions and were covered in the present survey. The nursery and kindergarten institution were treated as unrecognised institutions if not recognised by the Directorate of Education/Directorate of Public Instructions. Similarly, middle, secondary, higher secondary institutions etc. if not recognised by the authorised agency were treated as unrecognised institutions.

1.7 This report is based on data collected in Schedule 2.52B canvassed in the central sample. It gives number of unrecognised educational non-directory establishments, estimated employment, earnings, expenditure and government grants & donations by States, Union Territories and all-India separately by rural and urban sectors. Section II gives concepts and definition used in the survey and Section III gives summary findings of the survey. Appendix I gives statistical tables. A note on sample design and estimation procedure is given in Appendix II and Appendix III gives the facsimile of the enquiry schedule.

SECTION TWO  
CONCEPTS AND DEFINITIONS

- 2.1 Some of the important concepts and definitions followed in the survey are given below
- 2.2 Enterprises : An enterprise was an undertaking engaged in production and/or distribution of some goods and/or services not for the sole purpose of domestic consumption and carried out by members of the household/institutional body and/or hiring outside labour. An enterprise might be owned and operated by a single household or by several households jointly (on a partnership basis) or by an institutional body.
- 2.3 Establishment : An enterprise with at least one hired worker on a fairly regular basis was called an establishment. An establishment with six or more workers (including both household and hired) and/or with annual output/turnover/receipt Rs.1,00,000 or more was termed a directory establishment. On the other hand, an establishment with less than six workers and annual output/turnover/receipt less than Rs.1,00,000 was termed a non-directory establishment.
- 2.4 Recognised and unrecognised educational establishments : Educational establishments conducting courses which were prescribed or recognised by Central or State Government or by other authorised agency and which satisfied one or these authorities were treated as recognised educational establishments. The students of such institutions were ordinarily eligible for admission to test or examination conducted by the university or the board or by any other authorised agency. An educational institution conducting courses not recognised by the Central or State Government or by other authorised agency was treated as unrecognised institution. The nursery and kindergarten institutions were treated as unrecognised institutions if not recognised by the Directorate of Education/Directorate of Public Instruction. The primary institutions if not recognised by the Directorate of Education/Directorate of Public Instruction were treated as unrecognised institutions. Similarly, middle, secondary, higher secondary institutions etc. if not recognised by any authorised agency were treated as unrecognised institutions.

An institution conducting at least one course of study recognised by an authorised agency and one or more courses not recognised by any authorised agency was treated as a recognised institution. Such institutions were kept out of coverage of the survey.

**2.5 Ownership :** Establishments owned by a single or a group of persons with no participation of the government, local body etc. in it both in terms of management and shares were covered. Co-operative societies run with the shares of government, local body etc. were also covered. Each enterprise was categorised under any one of the following types of ownership.

(i) **Proprietary** : Type of ownership was said to be proprietary where an individual was the sole owner of the enterprise.

(ii) **Partnership** : Where there were two or more owners of the enterprise on a partnership basis, with or without formal registration, type of ownership of the enterprise was categorised as partnership.

(iii) **Co-operative Society** : When the enterprise was owned by a co-operative society, type of ownership was categorised as co-operative society.

(iv) **Registered and unregistered institutions** : An enterprise with institutional ownership, registered under public trust or Society's Act, was termed a registered institution. An enterprise with ownership neither proprietary nor partnership but rather institutional without being a public limited, or private limited company or co-operative society and not registered under Society's Act was termed an unregistered institution.

**2.6 Regular course and supplementary course** : Regular courses were systematic courses which were meant to prepare the students academically or technically or otherwise for a certificate or diploma or degree. Supplementary courses were supporting courses to regular courses. Such courses were meant to aid the student attending some regular course to gain further proficiency in the regular course. Certain courses through which students were not necessarily prepared for any degree, diploma or certificate such as courses for competitive examinations conducted by service commissions, selection tests for admission into degree, diploma classes were, however, treated as regular course for the purpose of the survey.

An educational establishment conducting both regular and supplementary courses were treated as conducting combined courses whereas an establishment conducting regular courses only or supplementary courses only were treated as conducting respectively regular courses or supplementary course.

2.7 Employment-Hired Staff : Persons employed in an enterprise on regular wage or salary were treated as hired staff. Apprentices, paid or unpaid and proprietors receiving regular salary were treated as hired staff.

Employment-Not hired staff : Persons working in or for the enterprise without regular wage or salary were treated as not hired staff.

2.8 Earnings : Earnings included fees, commission and charges for services receivable by the enterprise.

2.9 Government grants : Recurring and non-recurring annual aid from the central, state and local government.

2.10 Donation : Recurring and non-recurring annual cash assistance from persons, national and international organisations.

2.11 Emoluments Wages, allowances, retirement benefits, social benefits, such as employer's contribution to employee's state insurance to hired staff and other benefits such as ex-gratia payment or bonus, benefit, in kind etc. to hired as well as not hired staff were included.

2.12 Rent for assets not owned Rent for assets not owned w rent payable for the reference period for assets hired for the enterprise.

2.13 Interest on loan : Interest payable for the reference period for current loan and also outstanding loans taken prior to the reference period for the enterprise was treated as interest on loan.

2.14 Total recurring expenditure Total recurring expenditure wa total of salary, rent for assets not owned, interest on loan and other operational expenditure of the enterprise. It excluded all the expenditure of a capital nature.

- 2.15 Operating surplus : Operating surplus was total receipt on earnings less amount payable on salary, rent for assets not owned, interest on loan, maintenance expenditure on building and other assets and other operational expenditure.
- 2.16 Value added : Amount payable on salary, rent for assets not owned and interest on loan when added to operating surplus was value added.
- 2.17 Reference period : The reference period for the different items was last year. For establishments maintaining regular books of accounts information for the last accounting year was collected. For establishments not maintaining accounts information for last 365 days ending on the day preceding the date of enquiry was collected. However, data on employment and enrolment of students were collected specifically with respect to two time points within the same reference period, namely, 30th September and 31st March.

SECTION THREE  
SUMMARY RESULTS

3.1 Table 1 below presents estimated number of unrecognised educational non-directory establishments by nature of course conducted and type of ownership of the establishment separately for rural and urban sectors. In the table proprietary & partnership enterprises have been shown under non-institutional and all other enterprises under institutional ownership. It is seen from the table that at all-India level there were 43087 unrecognised educational non-directory establishments of which 21108 were located in the rural areas and the remaining 21979 were in the urban areas. That is to say about 49 and 51 per cent of the total number of establishments were located respectively in the rural and urban areas. In the rural sector about 64 per cent of the establishments were under institutional ownership and only 36 per cent under non-institutional ownership. The picture was, however, different in the urban sector where 60 per cent of the establishments were under non-institutional ownership and only 40 per cent under institutional ownership. It is seen from columns 6 and 7 of the table that about 68 per cent of the establishments both in the rural and urban areas were conducting regular courses for degrees, diploma or certificate. In the rural areas about 30 per cent of the establishments were conducting supplementary courses to regular courses and only 2 per cent of the establishments were conducting both regular and supplementary courses. In the urban areas about 19 per cent and 12 per cent of the establishments were conducting respectively supplementary courses only and both regular and supplementary courses.

3.2 Table 2 below presents estimated number of persons employed in unrecognised educational non-directory establishments in the country broken down by rural and urban sectors. It is seen from the table that at all-India level about 1.18 lakh persons were employed in such establishments with 63 thousand persons in the urban sector and 50 thousand persons in the rural sector. From col.(5) of the table it is seen that in the rural sector about 68 per cent, 31 per cent and 1 per cent of the persons were employed respectively in the establishments conducting (i) regular course, (ii) supplementary course and (iii) both regular and supplementary courses. In the urban sector, about 71 per cent, 18 per cent and 11 per cent of the persons were employed respectively in establishments conducting (i) regular course, (ii) supplementary course (iii) both regular and supplementary courses.

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3.3 Table 3 below presents annual earnings, emoluments, rent and interest payments, expenditure on all items and value added per establishment by type of establishment separately by rural and urban sectors. It is seen from the table that in the rural sector per establishment earnings, emoluments, rent and interest payments, expenditure on all items and value added per establishment for all establishments combined were respectively Rs.2043, Rs.2092, Rs.3018 and Rs.1116. In the urban sector the corresponding estimates of earnings, emoluments rent and interest payments, expenditure on all items and value added per establishment for all establishments combined were respectively Rs.5245, Rs.3294, Rs.4208 and Rs.4331. In the rural sector value added per establishment for establishments conducting supplementary courses was highest being Rs.2020 per annum. In the urban sector value added per establishment for establishments conducting (i) regular courses and (ii) supplementary courses were nearly equal, each being about Rs.4400 per annum. Col.5 of the table gives net receipt per establishment defined as excess of earnings over expenditure on all items. It is seen from the table that in the rural sector for all the three different types of establishments net receipt per establishment was negative, the average value for all establishments combined being - Rs.975. In the urban sector the picture, however, was completely different. The average value of net receipt per establishment for all establishments combined was Rs.1036 per annum. From column (7), it is seen that the gap between earnings and expenditure per establishment in the rural sector was, however, balanced by private donations and government grants. In the urban sector private donations and government grants made the economic position of the establishments more stable.

APPENDIX - IISAMPLE DESIGN AND ESTIMATION PROCEDURE

1. Basic design : The sample design in both rural and urban areas was a stratified two stage one with enumeration blocks (EB<sub>s</sub>) of economic census being first stage units and enterprises in sample EB<sub>s</sub> being second stage units.

2. Stratification : There were 73 regions all over India (excluding areas not covered by NSS). These regions were formed within a state/union territory except in Gujarat by grouping contiguous districts of similar agricultural profile. In Gujarat, regions were formed by grouping contiguous tehsils taking into consideration the concentration of tribal population and dry areas of the state. Each district was treated as a stratum except in Gujarat where parts of a district belonging to different regions were treated as different strata.

3. Sampling frame : The enumeration blocks (EB) formed during 1977 Economic Census showing the number of DE and NDE for the different industries for each EB were used as sampling frame for the selection of EB<sub>s</sub>, the first stage units of sampling. However, due to non-availability of EC frame, UPS frame was used as the sampling frame for the urban areas of Nagaland and 1971 census list of villages was used as sampling frame for rural areas of Chandigarh.

4. Sub-strata : All the EB<sub>s</sub> in each district/stratum were divided into 2 sub-strata. Sub-stratum 1 consisted of all EB<sub>s</sub> having at least one DE and/or NDE in any of the 4 industries namely, (i) trade, (ii) hotel and restaurant, (iii) transport and (iv) storage and warehousing. Residual EB<sub>s</sub> constituted sub-stratum 2. However, in rural areas of Gujarat, 3 sub-strata were formed by sub-dividing sub-stratum 2 in two parts, viz. EB<sub>s</sub> not having any DE or NDE in any of the 4 industries specified above but containing at least one DE and/or NDE in any of the remaining industries covered by the Economic Census constituted sub-stratum 2 and the residual EB<sub>s</sub> constituted sub-stratum 3.

5. Allocation : The total sample size of enumeration blocks for the state/union territory was fixed on the basis of the number of investigators available for the survey in the state. The total number of sample EB<sub>s</sub> in a state or union territory was allocated to the rural and urban sectors of the districts in proportion to total number of directory and non-directory establishments in the four industries (viz. trade, hotel and restaurant, transport and storage & warehousing) in the respective districts and sectors. District-wise sample size was distributed between sub-stratum 1 and 2 approximately in the ratio 5 : 1, separately for the rural and urban sectors.

6. Selection of EB<sub>s</sub> : Sample EB<sub>s</sub> were selected from sub-stratum 1 with probability proportional to total number of DE + NDE under the industries namely, (i) trade, (ii) hotel and restaurant, (iii) transport and (iv) storage and warehousing with replacement. From sub-stratum 2 and sub-stratum 3 (in rural areas of Gujarat) sample EB<sub>s</sub> were selected at random.

7. Sub-division of EB<sub>s</sub> : Normally each sample EB was completely surveyed. But where the EB population exceeded 1,000 or number of DE + NDE exceeded 200, the EB was sub-divided into two or more sub-blocks of nearly equal population or DE + NDE content and the survey was confined to one of the sub-blocks selected at random.

8. Sampling of enterprises : There were 11 schedules of enquiry for the different enterprises under survey coverage as :

In each sample EB all the OAEs eligible for sch. 2.51B were surveyed. Also in each EB a maximum of 12 NDEs were surveyed. Further in each EB 3 OAEs other than OAEs eligible for sch 2.51B were surveyed. In EBs having no eligible NDE, 5 OAEs were surveyed.

NDE : When total number of NDEs eligible for survey exceeded 12 in an EB, 12 sample NDEs were distributed over different schedule types as follows. First, one NDE was allotted to each schedule type. Next, one more was allotted to each schedule type in the priority order of schedules 2.31B, 2.32B, 2.33B, 2.34B, 2.52B, 2.53B, 2.55B, 2.41B and 2.42B until the total number of sample NDEs became 12. This procedure was repeated as many times as warranted to arrive at 12 sample NDEs. Circular systematic sample of NDEs was selected independently from each schedule type.

OAE : A circular systematic sample of 3 or 5 OAEs, as required was selected taking all the schedule types (excluding schedule 2.51B) together.
