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

Section One

INTRODUCTION

1.0 The National Sample Survey Organisation (NSSO) has been conducting enquiries on Household Consumer Expenditure since 1972-73 on a quinquennial basis under its present ten-year work programme. The third survey in the new series on household consumer expenditure was conducted as a part of the 38th round (January 1983 to December 1983) survey operation. Basic results of the survey on consumer expenditure have been released through a series of reports from the month of September, 1985. A list of reports based on NSS 38th round consumer expenditure survey data prepared so far is ~~appended at the end of this report.~~

1.1 Apart from the information required for deriving the monthly consumer expenditure for a household, additional information was also collected, among other aspects of housing facilities, on the monthly rental values of the dwellings resided by the households of the urban sector only. In addition to the data on the actual monthly rent of the rented dwellings, information was also collected on imputed rent for the dwellings occupied otherwise. Imputation of the monthly rent of a dwelling was done on the basis of prevailing rate of rent for similar dwellings in the particular locality. In the case of rural sector as hiring-in of residential accommodation was not very common, the concept of prevailing rate of rent was, therefore, not appropriate. Accordingly, data on the actual or imputed rent of the dwellings were not collected for the rural households. This report is aimed to study the extent of

changes in the overall distribution of households by monthly per capita expenditure class after taking into account the effect of adjustment of imputed house rent for non-rented households for urban areas. The tables presented in this report give an idea about the extent of households which have exhibited displacement in their monthly per capita consumer expenditure classes after adjustment for the imputed house rent.

1.2 SURVEY PERIOD AND REFERENCE PERIOD : The field work of the 38th round survey was carried out during the calendar year 1983 starting from January and continuing upto December - thus covering a period of a complete year. The data collected on household consumer expenditure pertained to a moving reference period of 30 days preceding the day of enquiry and thus the estimates presented in this report broadly relate to the average pattern obtaining for the period from December 1982 to December 1983.

1.3 SAMPLE SIZE : The survey covered about 1,23,000 households spread over 8035 villages and 4379 urban blocks. In rural or urban areas of some of the states the number of sample villages or blocks fell far short of the respective numbers allotted. In Meghalaya, Tripura, Arunachal Pradesh and Lakshadweep quite a large proportions of sample (about 38 to 90 percent) remained unsurveyed. Due to this less coverage of the sample than what was ~~was~~ required, the results of the survey may not exhibit the real situation obtaining in these states. Hence, the results of these states have not been presented separately in the report. They are, however, ~~not~~ included in the all-India estimate.

1.4 PARTICIPATION OF STATES : In the 38th round survey all the states and union territories (included in the geographical coverage) except Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Chandigarh, Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Lakshadweep participated in the survey on at least equal matching basis. The results presented in this report are, however, based on the data of central samples only..

1.5 METHOD OF ADJUSTMENT : In the NSS 38th round survey, data were collected on the household consumer expenditure on various component which together form household consumption. This monthly consumer expenditure, in respect of households residing in rented dwellings, include also the rent of the dwelling for a reference period of 30 days preceding the day of enquiry. But for the households residing in dwellings which are not rented, the rental value does not arise and hence does not form a part of household consumer expenditure. However, for both such groups of households residing in rented as well as not rented dwellings, separate information was also collected on the actual rent or imputed rent depending on whether the dwelling was rented or occupied otherwise. In order to examine the impact of adjustment of house rent on the distribution of household consumer expenditure, the following adjustment procedure has been adopted.

Denoting by R as the imputed value of monthly house rent, the rent adjusted household monthly consumer expenditure (T') is given as

$$T' = T + R$$

where T = unadjusted household monthly ~~per capita~~ consumer expenditure;

Now $T' > \text{ or } = T$ depending on whether $R > \text{ or } = 0$. Or, in other words, the unadjusted household monthly per capita expenditure ($T/\text{household size}$) will be displaced to the right or will remain same if the imputed value of rent is greater than or equal to zero. It otherwise implies that the households belonging to an MPCE class will move to higher MPCE classes or will continue to belong to the same MPCE class if the imputed value of rent is positive or zero.

1.6 CONTENTS OF THE REPORT : The report contains detailed tables for urban sector in respect of 17 major states as also for all-India in the Appendix. Results for some of the states with small sample size in addition to those mentioned in para 1.3 have not been presented. Besides these tables, other sections of the report contain (i) Concepts and Definitions (ii) Sampling Design and Estimation Procedure (iii) Explanatory Notes on Tables and (iv) Summary of Findings.

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Section Two

CONCEPTS AND DEFINITIONS

2.0 The concepts and definitions followed in household consumer expenditure survey during 38th round have broadly remained same as in previous NSS rounds. Some of these concepts and definitions are explained below.

2.1 HOUSEHOLD : A household is a group of persons normally living together and taking food from a common kitchen. A boarding house, a hotel or a hostel is treated as a cluster of households where each individual boarder (with his dependent or guests) forms a separate household by itself. Households maintained and provided food directly by government, such as those in prisons, police quarters, cantonments, hospitals, asylums, relief camps are, however, excluded from the scope of the survey.

2.2 HOUSEHOLD SIZE : The total number of members in a household is considered to be the household size.

2.3 HOUSEHOLD CONSUMER EXPENDITURE : Household consumer expenditure comprises of all expenditure incurred by a household, exclusively on domestic account, including consumption out of home-grown produce or transfer receipts like gift, loan etc. The expenditure on household enterprise is excluded from consumer expenditure. While consumption out of transfer receipts is included, transfer payments of all kinds (loans, gifts, charities, cash as well as in kind e.g. grain loan etc.) are excluded. Expenditure on purchase and construction of residential houses are considered to be on capital account and therefore are outside the purview of the consumer expenditure, but the expenditure towards repair and maintenance of residential building as also the rent of the hired dwellings resided by the household are included in the consumer expenditure of the household. Monetary value of food items consumed during the reference period is taken to represent consumer expenditure on

food items. This also included consumption of food articles in ceremonies performed in the household during the reference period while quantity consumed by domestic animals like cattle etc. are not included under domestic consumption, consumption by pet animals like cats, dogs, birds etc. are included. For semi-durable and durable goods, the actual expenditure incurred towards purchase of these articles, during the reference period is considered as the consumer expenditure of the household. For items of clothing and foot-wear etc. monetary value of the articles brought into first use during the reference period is taken as the consumer expenditure on the articles concerned.

2.4 REFERENCE PERIOD : The reference period used for household consumer expenditure survey is a moving one in the sense that this period is always linked with the day of enquiry. But for items of clothing and foot-wear, durable goods and some items of miscellaneous goods and services data have also been collected for a reference period of last 365 days preceding the day of enquiry in addition to that for a reference period of last 30 days. Monthly Per Capita Expenditure Classes are, however, based on data pertaining to a reference period of last 30 days only which is referred as unadjusted MPCE in this report. This MPCE when adjusted considering the imputed value of rent of the non-rented dwellings as per the procedure mentioned in para 1.5 of section one is considered as rent adjusted MPCE.

2.5 DWELLING UNIT : Dwelling unit is the existing housing accommodation available to the household for its residential purpose. It may be an entire building, hutment, thatched house or jhopri or a portion thereof used jointly by the household either exclusively or jointly with other households.

2.6 MONTHLY RENT (ACTUAL AND IMPUTED) : Monthly rent is the amount of money payable per month to the owner or to some other party as per the contract between the occupier of the accommodation and person who lets it out. For houses occupied otherwise than on rent, imputation of rent is done on the basis of the prevailing rate of rent for similar houses in the locality.

Section Three

SAMPLE DESIGN AND ESTIMATION PROCEDURE

3.0 SAMPLING DESIGN : The sampling design adopted in the 38th round survey was a two-stage stratified one with census villages in the rural areas and urban frame survey (UFS) blocks in the urban areas as first stage units and households as second stage units. The sample villages were selected with probability proportional to size and with replacement in the form of two independent interpenetrating samples while the sample blocks were selected with equal probability also in the form of two independent interpenetrating samples. After arranging all households of the first stage units in a specified manner ten sample households from each first stage unit were selected following a circular systematic sampling design.

3.1 SAMPLING FRAME : The sampling frame for the rural areas was the list of villages as per 1981 decennial population census except for Assam where 1971 census list of villages had been used. For the urban areas the list of urban frame survey (UFS) blocks had been used as sampling frames.

3.2 SURVEY PERIOD AND LOGISTICS : The survey started from January 1983 and continued upto December 1983. The entire survey period of one year was divided into four sub-rounds each of three months duration as follows :

- January 1983 to March 1983 : sub-round 1
- April 1983 to June 1983 : sub-round 2
- July 1983 to September 1983 : sub-round 3
- October 1983 to December 1983 : sub-round 4

The samples were equally distributed over the four sub-rounds in a manner so as to provide equally valid estimates for each of the selected sub-round period. The average based on the pooled data for all the sub-rounds taken together would account for seasonal variations and thus would be free from seasonal effects.

3.3 Estimation Procedure : The estimation procedure adopted in the 38th round is based on weighted sum of sample values. Denoting by \hat{Y} , the unbiased estimate of Y (the state total of any variate) it is given by :

for the rural sector, and

$$\hat{Y} = \sum_s \frac{N_s}{n_s} \cdot \sum_i D_{si} \cdot \frac{H_{si}}{h_{si}} \cdot \sum_j Y_{sij} \quad \dots(2)$$

for the urban sector

where s , i and j stand for stratum, village/urban block and household respectively; P_s , N_s and n_s denote the population, number of villages/blocks in the frame and number of sample villages/blocks for the s^{th} stratum respectively; D_{si} , e_{si} and p_{si} denote the number of hamlet groups/sub-blocks formed, number of sample villages contained in a large revenue village and the population for the i^{th} sample village in the s^{th} stratum respectively; H_{si} and h_{si} stand for the i^{th} village/block in the s^{th} stratum respectively; and finally Y_{sij} is the observed value of the variate for the j^{th} sample household in the i^{th} village/block belonging to s^{th} stratum. Estimates of ratio of the characteristics is given by the ratios of the estimates of their aggregates.

Section Four

EXPLANATORY NOTES ON TABLES

4.0 The tables presented in this report give the percentage distribution of households over rent adjusted monthly per capita expenditure classes by unadjusted monthly per capita expenditure classes for 17 major states and all India for urban sector only.

4.1 Monthly Per Capita Expenditure Classes:

Results in the tables are shown by monthly per capita expenditure classes (Rs.). The ranges have been arranged in ascending order of their magnitudes as 0-30, 30-40, 40-50, 50-60, 60-70, 70-85, 85-100, 100-125, 125-150, 150-200, 200-250, 250-300 & above and all expenditure classes.

4.2 Rent Adjusted Monthly Per Capita Expenditure Classes : For each household the monthly per capita consumer expenditure has been adjusted by applying the appropriate adjustment factor as explained in section one para 1.5. The households within each MPCE class have been distributed over rent adjusted monthly consumer expenditure classes after adjustment and presented in the tables. The ranges of this rent adjusted MPCE classes are same as those of unadjusted MPCE classes.

SECTION FIVE

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

5.1 The results of 38th round consumer expenditure survey cross classified by different household monthly per capita expenditure (MPCE) classes had already been released. As it has been stated in section two of this report, this household MPCE is based on all items of household consumption viz. food and non-food including rent paid for the rented-in dwellings during a period of last 30 days preceding the day of enquiry. The object of the present report is to study the impact of the adjustment for imputed value of house rent for non-rented households on the distribution of households by MPCE classes.

5.2 It has been mentioned earlier that in addition to collection of information on various components of household consumption information was also collected on the actual monthly rent paid and also imputed value of the rent depending on whether the households resided in rented dwellings or dwellings occupied otherwise. Since the rented values of owner occupied houses or similar other dwellings have got a bearing on the pattern of monthly per capita expenditure, it is of interest to study as to how the overall distribution of households gets affected after adjustment for imputed rent. Statement 1 gives the percentage of households who are not residing in rented dwellings but reported the imputed rent for selected states and all India.

It is seen that at all India level about 7 per cent of such households did not report imputed rent for their dwellings which were not rented-in. While percentage of such non-reporting was quite high in Himachal Pradesh (44), Bihar (21) closely followed by Jammu & Kashmir (15), Orissa (16), Assam (13) and Gujarat (13) it is very low in respect of other states. While in Maharashtra nearly all households reported imputed rent with percentage of non-reporting being of the order of only 1, in all the southern states of Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Kerala and Karnataka the percentage of such non-reporting households varied between 2 and 4.

5.3 Statement 2 gives the ~~percentage~~^{percentage} of households ~~not~~^{new-} residing in rented houses by monthly per capita expenditure classes for selected states and all India. It is evident from the results that at all India level about 37 per cent of the urban households were found to be tenant households during 1983. While between one-third and one-half of the urban households were found to be tenants in Himachal Pradesh (50 p.c.), Maharashtra (47 p.c.), West Bengal (46 p.c.), Tamil Nadu (43 p.c.), Karnataka (41 p.c.), Gujarat (40 p.c.), Andhra Pradesh (38 p.c.), Madhya Pradesh (34 p.c.) and Punjab (33 p.c.), the corresponding percentage of tenant households were comparatively lower in Bihar (31 p.c.), Uttar Pradesh (30 p.c.), Haryana (30 p.c.), Assam (27 p.c.), Orissa (26 p.c.) and Rajasthan (26 p.c.). In Kerala and Jammu & Kashmir, the percentage of such tenant households was relatively very low being of the order of about 16 and 15 respectively. It is further seen that the percentage of persons not residing in rented houses decreases with the rising level of monthly per capita expenditure which otherwise implies that the extent of tenancy is more prevalent among the households belonging to higher expenditure classes than among those belonging to lower rung. This also supports the general view that richer households are relatively in a better position to afford a rented dwelling.

5.4 Statement 3 gives for selected states and all India the percentage of households showing (i) no change and (ii) movement upwards (i.e., movement to higher expenditure classes) after

adjustment of rent by monthly per capita expenditure classes. It is seen from this statement that the percentage of households exhibiting upward movement (i.e. towards higher expenditure classes) after adjustment are found to decline, though not smoothly, with the increasing level of per capita expenditure. Thus it may be stated that, in general, adjustment of rent did not yield much effect on the households belonging to higher MPCE classes when compared to those belonging to lower classes. It is also otherwise evident from the extent of occupancy of dwellings over different MPCE classes that the percentage of tenant households is rather dominant among the higher classes or in other words, the effect of imputation of rent for non-rented dwellings is not so significant and therefore, it causes comparatively less displacement of the richer households to higher expenditure classes.

Appendix - I

IMPUTED RENT FOR HOUSEHOLDS LIVING IN NON-RENTED
HOUSES AND THE EFFECT OF ITS INCLUSION ON MONTHLY
PER CAPITA EXPENDITURE

1.0 The tables presented in the report show the overall movement of households belonging to a particular monthly per capita expenditure (MPCE) class to higher expenditure classes after inclusion of imputed rent for the households living in non-rented dwelling units. In this appendix, an attempt has been made to separate out the two groups of households viz., households living in rented house and the other households, and to show their respective distribution over MPCE classes. For the latter group, the reported imputed rent has been added to the total monthly household expenditure of the respective households and their distribution over MPCE classes has been derived afresh. Using this procedure, for all India urban, the adjusted distributions of households after inclusion of imputed rent have been derived for (i) households dwelling in non-rented houses and (ii) all households, over MPCE classes. These adjusted distributions have been compared graphically with the original (ignoring imputed rent) distributions of households living in (i) rented house, (ii) non-rented house and (iii) all households over MPCE classes.

1.1 Procedure of estimation : The percentage of households living in rented house out of all households belonging to a MPCE class, as shown in the report, has been used to obtain the estimated number of households of that class living in rented house and by subtraction, the distribution of other households over MPCE classes has been separately derived. Thus, the last two lines of the tables, presented in this report, provided the required estimates.

1.2 MPCE on house rent : The average MPCE on house rent actually paid and the reported imputed rent is shown for the households dwelling in rented houses and for other households respectively, by MPCE class, in Statement I-1. In general, the average rent paid or imputed, increases with the increasing level of MPCE. The average MPCE on house rent is Rs. 17.36 for households dwelling in rented house whereas the average imputed MPCE on rent reported by other households is Rs. 25.70. It is observed that for any expenditure class, the imputed rent (for non-rented dwellers) is nearly double the amount of actual rent (paid by rented dwellers). The average rent, actual and imputed, by MPCE is shown graphically in Chart - 1.

Distribution of households over MPCE classes (including imputed rent) : The average imputed rent for any MPCE class being larger compared to the actual rent as observed from Statement I-1, its inclusion substantially changes the distribution pattern of the households dwelling in non-rented houses, over MPCE classes. Setting aside, the lowest MPCE class of Rs. '0 - 30' (which for several reasons may exhibit peculiarities completely out of tune with the general pattern or trend), it is observed that the proportion of households dwelling in rented houses gradually increases from 14.13 in MPCE class Rs. 30-40 to 52.57 percent in the highest expenditure class of Rs. 300 & above.

The percentage distribution of households dwelling in (i) rented houses, (ii) owned or otherwise occupied houses (a) excluding and (b) including the imputed value of rent and (iii) all households (a) excluding and (b) including the imputed value of rent, over MPCE classes, are shown in Statement I-2.

Inclusion of imputed rent in total expenditure of non-rented dwellers considerably improves their distribution over MPCE classes but even then, their rent adjusted distribution remains less favourable than that for households living in rented house. In fact the distributions indicate that the households dwelling in rented houses have a higher average MPCE. The percentages of households below specific MPCE levels, for households dwelling in rented house, other households and all households including and excluding imputed rent have been graphically presented in Charts-2, 3 and 4.

1.4 As the average MPCE from the different distributions can not be derived directly from the available results, the distributions can be broadly assessed by looking into the terminal MPCE's at 20th, 50th and 80th percentile of households which are presented in Statement I-3, for the five sets of distribution. While the terminal expenditure for all the three percentile points is the highest for the rented dwellers, it is the lowest for the other households. Even after adjustment with imputed rent, non-rented dwellers have lower terminal MPCE's compared to the corresponding terminal MPCE's of all households at all the three percentile points.

1.5 The results examined in this appendix have been shown in the charts presented below. It has been observed that either imputed rent or the actual rent is proportional to the total average MPCE. In Chart -1, along with the actual/imputed rent by MPCE, the fitted lines have also been drawn to get a visual impression about the closeness of the two. The equation of the fitted lines are : $Y = 0.09x - 0.39$ for actual rent, and $Y = 0.18x - 0.88$ for imputed rent; where x stands for average MPCE (actual) and Y, stands for average MrCE on rent (actual/imputed).








