

## PUBLIC HEALTH STATISTICS

Available information concerning public health statistics in India, is shown in the tables under this section. Data in greater detail are published by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India and the various State authorities in the form of periodical reports. The information relates to all the Indian Union, unless otherwise specified. The figures for the latest available year are shown in greater detail. Corresponding figures for the earlier years are shown in totals only.

This table shows the number of hospitals and dispensaries and the number of beds available.

### Table 32.2

This table gives the number of medical practitioners in 'Allopathy', registered with the 'Medical Councils' in the States. Information relating to States, where there are no 'Medical Councils', have not been included.

This table gives the number of nursing personnel registered with 'Nursing Councils' or 'Boards' according to different categories.

### Table 32.4

Data concerning number of mental hospitals, beds, patients admitted and discharged, etc. are shown in this table. For the column on patients discharged, only total number is given and the break-up by cured and otherwise is not shown.

### Table 32.5

The figures of Family Welfare Statistics, given in the table are based on the information received from the various States/Union Territories and compiled by the Department of Family Welfare.

The Number of conventional contraceptive users is arrived at by dividing the off-taking of condoms, and oral pills by 72 and 13 respectively on an average by a couple in a year to give complete protection.
