OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Recovery of excess payments made to Government servants including the applicants in OA No.2304/06, OA No.109/07, OA No.646/07, OA No.2132/08, OA No.2186/08, OA No.2645/08, MA No.1558/08, OA No.35/09 and CP(c) No.400/11 in OA No.2131/08, MA No.1006/2011-Regarding.

The undersigned is directed to refer to the subject and to say that the issue of pay fixation in respect of the incumbents absorbed and appointed as Statistical Investigators Grade-I of SSS in the pay scale of ₹7,450-225-11,500 (NFSG) under FR 22(1)(a)(ii) w.e.f. 1st April 2004 was pending with the CCA of SSS after serving several notices to the concerned officers in the light of the above mentioned OA/MAs etc. vide this Ministry's Notice No.11024/26/2006-SSS dated 05.12.2007, OM dated 13.01.2007 and Order dated 29th August 2008 of even number; OM No.11024/18/2008 -SSS dated 10.10.2008 and Order No.11024/26/ 2006-SSS dated 28.03.2011, etc.

2. In pursuance of the decision of Government of India issued vide DoP&T O.M. No.18/26/2011-Estt(Pay-I) dated 6th February 2014, it is stated that in supersession to this Ministry OM No.11024/26/2006-SSS dated 20.4.2011 it has now been decided by the CCA of SSS, with the concurrence of AS&FA of this Ministry, to fix the pay of applicants of above mentioned OAs, on account of their absorption and appointment as Statistical Investigators Grade-I of SSS, in the pay scale of ₹7,450-225-11,500 (NFSG) under FR 22(1)(a)(ii) w.e.f. 1st April 2004 and to recover excess payment made to the concerned officers of SSS.

3. The excess payment made, if any, shall be recovered from the concerned incumbents in three equal monthly installments. In case an officer is going to superannuate earlier, the duration of recovery may be reduced accordingly. However, it may be ensured that the excess payment, in any case, has to be recovered before his superannuation.

4. All participating Ministries/Departments/Organizations are requested to take immediate action to re-fix the pay of the concerned incumbents and recovery of excess payments under intimation to this Ministry.

5. This issues with the approval of the competent authority.
