ORDER

Subject: Grant of Assured Career Progression (ACP) to SI Grade I of SSS- Regarding

In pursuance of, DOP&T's OM No. 35034 / 1 / 97 – Estt. (D) dated 9th August 1999 and guidelines to regularize ACP in SSS on the consideration of recommendation of Special Departmental Anomaly Committee issued vide OM No. 11024 / 14 / 2006 – SSS dated 13th May 2011, 15th July 2011 and 15th September 2011 and on the recommendation of the Screening Committee, meeting of which was held on 28th January 2013, the Competent Authority has approved grant of 1st & 2nd ACP in the pay scale of **6500 – 10500 & 8000 - 13500**, on personal basis, in line of promotional hierarchy prescribed in their organization to Statistical Investigator Grade I & II, who were in the pay scale of **Rs. 5000 – 8000 & 6500 -10500** and of Subordinate Statistical Service (SSS) and were eligible for 1st & 2nd ACP on completion of more than 12 & 24 years of regular service before 12th February 2002 as per details given below:

2. The officers are entitled for fixation of pay as per the provisions of CCS (Revised Pay) Rules, 1997 and the ACP guidelines.
3. The Participating Ministries / Department / Organization of SSS are requested to fix the pay under higher Pay Scale after due verification of eligibility condition of ACP from the service records of the officers.
4. The Participating Ministries / Department / Organization of SSS are requested to see that officer placed in the higher Pay Scale under ACP, was not under suspension or no charge sheet was issued or no disciplinary proceeding or prosecution case for criminal charge was pending against him on the crucial date.
5. The officer, if any, who is under currency of penalty, will be placed in the next higher Pay as per ACP Scheme only on expiry of that period.
6. Pay granted under ACP scheme before 12th February 2002 in the pay scale available in SSS will be allowed to continue. As such ACP granted in the pay scale of Rs. 5500 – 9000, and Rs. 6500 – 10500 will continue with all consequential benefits. However, ACP granted prior to formation of SSS in the pay scale of Rs. **8000 – 13500** will be allowed to continue only up to 11th February 2002 and same will be placed in the lower scale of Rs. **7450 – 11500** w.e.f. 12th February 2002 and any drop in Pay will be protected by treating the difference as personal pay and the same will be adjusted in future increments. As such there will not be any recovery.
7. In case of incumbents of SSS, who have earned 1st or 2nd ACP on or before **31.12.2005** in four grades structure of the service, there would be no change in MACP orders. Pay of official who earned pay scale of Rs. 6500 – 10500 under 1st or 2nd ACP, would be regulated under PB- 2, with Grade Pay of Rs. 4200 w.e.f. 01.01.2006 in the light of this ministry's OM No. S- 11039 / 1 / 2008 – SSS dated 12th October 2009 and subsequent OM No. 12012 / 4 (2) / 2011 – SSS dated 6th June 2012 with all consequential benefits.
8. MACP benefits extended on completion of 10, 20 and 30 years of regular service as on 01.09.2008 and after will remain unchanged.
9. The Participating Ministries / Department / Organization of SSS is requested to provide copy of this order to all concerned incumbents and place a copy of the same in service book of officials.
